7. MINOR-STRUCTURE PERMIT, POINT MUGU, VENTURA COUNTY; COMMANDER, U. S. NAVAL MISSILE CENTER - W.O. 6009, P.R.C. 3846.9.

After consideration of Calendar Item 34 attached, and upon motion duly made and carried, the following resolution was adopted:

THE COMMISSION AUTHORIZES THE ISSUANCE TO THE COMMANDER, U. S. NAVAL MISSILE CENTER, POINT MUGU, CALIFORNIA, OF A TWO-YEAR PERMIT FOR THE USE AND MAINTENANCE OF TWO ARTIFICIAL REEFS IN CONSIDERATION OF THE PUBLIC BENEFIT ON THE FOLLOWING-DESCRIBED LAND:

TWO CIRCULAR PARCELS OF SUBMERGED LAND, 60 FEET IN DIAMETER, IN SANTA BARBARA CHANNEL, VENTURA COUNTY, IN THE VICINITY OF MUGU LAGOON, THE CENTER POINTS OF SAID PARCELS BEING DESCRIBED AS FOLLOWS:

PARCEL NO. 1: 119° 06' 02" W. LONGITUDE
34° 05' 38" N. LATITUDE

PARCEL NO. 2: 119° 05' 49" W. LONGITUDE
34° 05' 50" N. LATITUDE

EACH PARCEL CONTAINING 0.065 ACRE.

MINOR-STRUCTURE PERMIT

APPLICANT: Commander, U. S. Naval Missile Center

LOCATION: Point Mugu, Ventura County, California

PROPOSED USE: Two artificial reefs, constructed of steel pontoons, each reef being 14 feet wide and 52 feet long. The reefs provide a source of specimens for studies of the Marine Science Division of the Missile Center.

TERM: Initial period: 2 years, from August 26, 1967

CONSIDERATION: No charge. The public benefit.

PREREQUISITE ITEMS:
U. S. Army Corps of Engineers navigational permit issued.
Applicant is owner of upland.
