

23. EXTENSION OF TIME LIMIT, P.R.C. 3502.1, SUBMERGED LANDS, RUSSIAN RIVER, SONOMA COUNTY; UTAH CONSTRUCTION AND MINING COMPANY.

After consideration of Calendar Item 49 attached, and upon motion duly made and unanimously carried, the following resolution was adopted:

THE COMMISSION AUTHORIZES THE EXTENDING TO JUNE 28, 1969, OF THE TIME WITHIN WHICH UTAH CONSTRUCTION & MINING COMPANY MAY OPEN THE MOUTH OF THE RUSSIAN RIVER UNDER THE TERMS OF MINERAL EXTRACTION LEASE P.R.C. 3502.1; ALL OTHER TERMS AND CONDITIONS OF SAID LEASE INCLUDING, WITHOUT LIMITATION OF THE GENERALITIES OF THE FOREGOING, THE OBLIGATION TO PAY THE ANNUAL RENTAL AND MINIMUM ROYALTY SPECIFIED IN SAID LEASE SHALL REMAIN UNCHANGED.

EXTENSION OF TIME LIMIT

LEASE: P.R.C. 3502.1

LESSEE: Utah Construction and Mining Company

LOCATION: Submerged lands, Russian River, Sonoma County

REQUEST: Lessee has applied for an extension of time in which to dredge an opening at the mouth of the Russian River, the dredging of which is required under provision of Paragraph 8(a), page 19, of the above lease which provides as follows:

"Within nine (9) months of the lease award, Lessee shall dredge an opening at the mouth of the Russian River to the hereinafter set forth standards. The aforesaid opening shall be at least fifteen (15) feet in depth at mean lower low water. The width of said opening shall be not less than one hundred fifty (150) feet at the river bottom. The aforesaid condition of navigability shall be maintained at least two hundred fifty (250) days of each year. The movement of all vessels through said opening shall be subject to standard navigational rules."

On June 22, 1967, the State Lands Commission granted lessee a similar extension through June 28, 1968.

REASON FOR EXTENSION:

The Utah Construction & Mining Company has made a sincere effort to comply with the requirements of said Paragraph 8(a), and has expended substantial sums of money and has conducted extensive studies concerning the feasibility of various methods to open the mouth of the Russian River.

Utah has applied for an extension of time in which to continue its studies and attempt to find a feasible means to keep the mouth of the river open.
