32. DEFERMENT OF DRILLING REQUIREMENTS, P.R.C. 3033.1, HUNTINGTON BEACH OFFSHORE, ORANGE COUNTY; UNION OIL COMPANY OF CALIFORNIA - W.O. 7295.

After consideration of Calendar Item 9 attached, and upon motion duly made and unanimously carried, the following resolution was adopted:

THE COMMISSION AUTHORIZES THE GRANTING TO UNION OIL COMPANY OF CALIFORNIA OF A DEFERMENT OF DRILLING REQUIREMENTS UNDER OIL AND GAS LEASE P.R.C. 3033.1 THROUGH DECEMBER 24, 1969; ALL OTHER TERMS AND CONDITIONS OF THE LEASE TO REMAIN IN FULL FORCE AND EFFECT.

DEFERMENT OF DRILLING REQUIREMENTS

P.R.C.: 3033.1.  
LESSEE: Union Oil Company of California.  
COUNTY: Orange.  
AREA: Huntington Beach offshore.  
ISSUED: July 25, 1963.  
WORK COMPLETED ON LEASE: Constructed platform "EVA"; drilled thirty-seven wells, thirty-two wells currently producing.  
PREVIOUS DEFERMENTS: From July 12, 1966, through June 24, 1969.  
THIS DEFERMENT: From June 25, 1969, through December 24, 1969.  
REASON FOR REQUEST: To complete interpretation of recently acquired air gun seismic data, and to obtain the final results of a gravity survey.
