APPLICANT: Herman B. Glebe, Ruby E. Glebe, and Richard L. Glebe.

LOCATION: Five miles northwest of the Geysers Steam Field, Lake County.

TYPE OF LAND: Patented school land, reserved mineral interest.

ACREAGE: 600.

SURFACE OWNER: Herman B. Glebe, Ruby E. Glebe and Richard L. Glebe.

The East half ( $E\frac{1}{2}$ ) of Section 22, and Northwest quarter of Northwest quarter ( $NW\frac{1}{4} NW\frac{1}{4}$ ), the South half of Northwest quarter ( $S\frac{1}{2} NW\frac{1}{4}$ ), the Northeast quarter of Southwest quarter ( $NE\frac{1}{4} SW\frac{1}{4}$ ), the Northwest quarter of Southeast quarter ( $NW\frac{1}{4} SE\frac{1}{4}$ ) and South half of Southeast quarter ( $S\frac{1}{2} SE\frac{1}{4}$ ) of Section 15, all in T. 12 N., R. 9 W., M.D.B. & M., Lake County, containing 600 acres more or less.
