56. DEFERMENT OF DRILLING REQUIREMENTS, LEASE P.R.C. 1824.1, SUMMERLAND OFFSHORE AREA, SANTA BARBARA COUNTY; STANDARD OIL COMPANY OF CALIFORNIA AND HUMBLE OIL & REFINING COMPANY - W-9041.

After consideration of Calendar Item 45 attached, and upon motion duly made and carried, the following resolution was adopted:

THE COMMISSION AUTHORIZES THE GRANTING TO STANDARD OIL COMPANY OF CALIFORNIA, WESTERN OPERATIONS, INC., OF A DEFERMENT OF DRILLING REQUIREMENTS UNDER OIL AND GAS LEASE P.R.C. 1824.1 THROUGH JUNE 9, 1970; ALL OTHER TERMS AND CONDITIONS OF THE LEASE TO REMAIN IN FULL FORCE AND EFFECT.

DEFERMENT OF DRILLING REQUIREMENTS

P.R.C.: 1824.1.

LESSEE: Standard Oil Company of California and Humble Oil & Refining Company.

OPERATOR: Standard Oil Company of California, Western Operations, Inc.

COUNTY: Santa Barbara.

AREA: Summerland offshore.

ISSUED: January 10, 1957.

WORK COMPLETED ON LEASE: Constructed two drilling and production platforms, "Hilda" and "Hazel". Drilled 52 wells and redrilled 28. Forty-five wells are currently producing.

PREVIOUS DEFERMENTS: From April 20, 1964, through December 9, 1969.

THIS DEFERMENT: From December 10, 1969, through June 9, 1970.

REASON FOR REQUEST: To continue comprehensive study being conducted by review team.
