10. EXTENSION OF GEOPHYSICAL SURVEY PERMIT P.R.C. 3182.1, OFFSHORE AREA FROM POINT SAN LUIS, SAN LUIS OBISPO COUNTY, THROUGH SAN DIEGO COUNTY; TEXACO INC.

EXTENSION OF GEOPHYSICAL SURVEY PERMIT  
P.R.C. 3182.1

PERMITTEE: Texaco Inc.

LOCATION: The offshore area lying between a line drawn due West from Point San Luis, San Luis Obispo County, and the southern boundary of the State of California, excepting the following-described areas (see Exhibit "A" attached):

- B. Lands included in Section 6871.2(b) of the Public Resources Code (Santa Barbara Sanctuary);
- C. Lands lying adjacent to the mainland between a line forming the Northwesterly Boundary of the City of Newport Beach, Orange County, and the seaward extension thereof, and a line forming the Southeasterly Boundary of Orange County, and the seaward extension thereof.

METHOD OF EXPLORATION:  
Seismic.

PRESENT PERMIT EXPIRES:  
February 28, 1970.

EXTENSION REQUESTED THROUGH:  
August 31, 1970.
