16. DEFERMENT OF DRILLING REQUIREMENTS, OIL & GAS LEASE P.R.C. 2991.1, SANTA BARBARA COUNTY; UNION OIL COMPANY OF CALIFORNIA - W-9118.

After consideration of Calendar Item 24 attached, and upon motion duly made and carried, the following resolution was adopted:

THE COMMISSION AUTHORIZES THE GRANTING TO UNION OIL COMPANY OF CALIFORNIA OF A DEFERMENT OF DRILLING REQUIREMENTS UNDER OIL AND GAS LEASE P.R.C. 2991.1 THROUGH MARCH 13, 1971; ALL OTHER TERMS AND CONDITIONS OF THE LEASE TO REMAIN IN FULL FORCE AND EFFECT.

P.R.C.: 2991.1.
LESSEE: Union Oil Company of California.

WORK COMPLETED ON LEASE:

Three wells drilled; two abandoned, one suspended.

PREVIOUS DEFERMENTS:

From March 14, 1966, through March 13, 1970.

THIS DEFERMENT:

From March 14, 1970, through March 13, 1971.

REASON FOR REQUEST: To continue evaluation of geologic data pending further determination of State policy concerning drilling in the Santa Barbara Channel.
