6. DEFERMENT OF DRILLING REQUIREMENTS, STATE OIL AND GAS LEASE PRC 2199.1, GAVIOTA AREA, SANTA BARBARA COUNTY; STANDARD OIL COMPANY OF CALIFORNIA AND CHELL OIL COMPANY - W 9338.

PRC: 2199.1.

LESSEE: Standard Oil Company of California and
Shell Oil Company.

OPERATOR: Standard Oil Company of California,
Western Operations, Inc.

COUNTY: Santa Barbara.

AREA: Gaviota.

ISSUED: July 25, 1958.

WORK COMPLETED ON LEASE:

Ten wells drilled, three from upland drillsites and seven from mobile drilling barges. Three upland wells currently producing. Conducted several seismic surveys.

PREVIOUS DEFERMENTS: From October 5, 1962, through April 4, 1971.

THIS DEFERMENT: From April 5, 1971, through October 4, 1971.

REASON FOR REQUEST: The operator is conducting reservoir studies and analyzing seismic data in order to determine the feasibility of additional development in the southern area of the lease.
