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The Creacent City Harbor District through the Board of Harbor Commissioners has requested the State Lands Commission to approve a boundary line agreement between the District and a littoral ownex, the Crescent City Harbor Company; the agreement is on file in the office of the Commission. The agreement provides for counterpart signatures so that other parties with smaller littoral parcels may later sign the agreement.

The line agreed to is the mean high tide line of 1948 , the so-called "Pond Line". This line was depicted as the limits of the legislative grant to the Crescent City Harbor District. In connection with this transaction, the line has been reviewed and recommended by the Division. The agreement as submitted has been redrafted and recommended by staff counsel and hes been reviewed and recommended by the office of the Attorney General. The agreement preserves whatever rights the public may have in the littoral lands adjacent to the agreed brundaiy.
