AREA, TYPE LAND AND LOCATION: An 0.044-acre parcel of tide and submerged land, Sandmound Slough, Bethel Island, Contra Costa County.

LAND USE: A single berth uncovered boat dock and gangway.

TERMS OF PROPOSED LEASE:

5 years, from January 1, 1974.

Surety bond: \$1,000.

CONSIDERATION: \$75 per annum.

BASIS FOR CONSIDERATION: \$75 fixed rental for this type of permit.

PREREQUISITE TERMS:

A 10 S 7 U. S. Army Corps of Engineers permit issued.

Applicant is owner of upland.

OTHER PERTINENT INFORMATION:

Code Section 2910, which exempts a floating dock or boathouse that will occupy no more than 3,000 square feet of tide and submerged land, including the area of use; provided that the lease of the land shall not exceed five years and a bond is provided to insure site clearance.
