A .091-acre parcel of tide and submerged land in Corte Madera Creek adjacent to Lot 2, Larkspur Plaza, Marin County.

LAND USE:

Construction and maintenance of a pier, ramp and floating dock.

TERMS OF PROPOSED LEASE:

10 years, from March 1, 1974. Initial period:
