21. QUITCLAIM OF MINERAL EXTRACTION LEASE PRC 2498.1, SAN FRANCISCO BAY NEAR RICHMOND; RHODES-JAMIESON GRAVEL - W 9711, PRC 2498.1.

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## QUITCLAIM OF MINERAL EXTRACTION LEASE

LEASE: Mineral Extraction Lease PRC 2498.1 (for the commercial extraction of sand).

LOCATION: San Francisco Bay near Richmond (471 acres).

LESSEE: Rhodes-Jamieson Gravel (original lessee).

LEASE DATE:

November 18, 1959, for twenty years, to November 18, 1979.

REASON FOR QUITCLAIM:

Costs for operating the lease for sand and gravel are more than lessee's costs for obtaining sand and gravel from other sources.

## OTHER PERTINENT DATA:

- Lease produced 21,000 C.Y. in 1960 and 37,000 C.Y. in 1961, under 4,000 C.Y. per year from 1961 to 1968; none since 1968.
- 2. Lessee submitted on November 17, 1973, the required Lease Quitclaim Deed.
- 3. All performance requirements of the lease have been met and all required payments have been received.
