THE COMMISSION:

PUBLIC AGENCY PERMITS

APPLICANT: California Department of Fish and Game.

AREA, TYPE LAND AND LOCATION:

Four separate parcels totaling 11.133 acres, more or less, of submerged lands within the Goose Flats backwater area of the Colorado River approximately 5 airline miles southeast of Blythe, Riverside County. Three separate parcels totaling 5.739 acres, more or less, of submerged lands within the Palo Verde Oxbow backwater area of the Colorado River, approximately 2.3 airline miles southerly of Palo Verde, Imperial County.

LAND USE: Artificial reef sites for fish habitat.

TERMS OF PROPOSED LEASE: Initial period: 10 years, from June 1, 1974.

CONSIDERATION: The public benefit, with the State reserving the right at any time to set a monetary rental if the Commission finds such action to be in the State's best interest.

STATUTORY AND OTHER REFERENCES:

a. Public Resources Code: Div. 6, Parts 1 and 2.
