A 0.042-acre parcel of tide and submerged land in Sandmound Slough near Bethel Island, Contra Costa County.

Maintenance of an existing floating open dock and walkway.

TERMS OF PROPOSED PERMIT:

Initial period: 5 years, from April 1, 1974.
