5. PUBLIC AGENCY PERMIT FOR INDEFINITE PERIOD, SUBMERGED LAND IN THE BED OF KINGS RIVER NEAR LEMOORE, KINGS COUNTY; CALIFORNIA DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION - W 20772, PRC 4982.

After consideration of Calendar Item 3 attached, and upon motion duly made and carried, the following resolution was adopted:

THE COMMISSION:

1. DETERMINES THAT AN ENVIRONMENTAL IMPACT REPORT HAS NOT BEEN PREPARED FOR THIS PROJECT, BUT THAT A NEGATIVE DECLARATION HAS BEEN PREPARED BY THE DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION, DIVISION OF HIGHWAYS, ON JUNE 2, 1972.
2. CERTIFIES THAT THE COMMISSION HAS REVIEWED AND CONSIDERED THE INFORMATION CONTAINED IN THE NEGATIVE DECLARATION.
3. DETERMINES THAT THE PROJECT WILL NOT HAVE A SIGNIFICANT EFFECT ON THE ENVIRONMENT.
4. AUTHORIZES THE ISSUANCE TO THE DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION OF A PUBLIC AGENCY PERMIT FOR AN INDEFINITE TERM FROM JANUARY 1, 1975; AND THE EXECUTION OF A PLAT PURSUANT TO STREETS AND HIGHWAYS CODE SECTION 101.5; IN CONSIDERATION OF THE MONETARY VALUE OF THE RIGHT-OF-WAY TO BE DEPOSITED IN THE GENERAL FUND FOR CREDIT TO THE RESOURCES PROTECTION ACCOUNT; FOR THE CONSTRUCTION OF TWO BRIDGES ON THE LANDS DELINEATED IN EXHIBITS A-1 AND A-2 ATTACHED AND BY REFERENCE MADE A PART HEREOF.

PUBLIC AGENCY PERMIT

APPLICANT: California Department of Transportation.

AREA, TYPE LAND AND LOCATION:

A 1.07-acre and a 0.35-acre parcel of submerged land in the bed of Kings River near Lemoore, Kings County.

LAND USE:

Construction of two bridges, one serving State Route 41 and the other serving an approach road to State Route 41, respectively.

TERMS OF PROPOSED LEASE:

Initial period: Indefinite period, from January 1, 1975.

CONSIDERATION: Determined by Section 101.5 of the Streets and Highways Code.

PREREQUISITE TERMS:

Applicant is owner of upland.

STATUTORY AND OTHER REFERENCES:

- a. Public Resources Code: Div. 6, Parts 1 and 2.
- b. Administrative Code: Title 2, Div. 3, Arts. 1, 2 & 10.
- c. Streets & Highways Code: Section 101.5.
- d. Chapter 1052, Statutes of 1969.

OTHER PERTINENT INFORMATION:

1. The 1.07-acre parcel will serve State Route 41 and the 0.35-acre parcel will serve the approach road to State Route 41.
2. The Department of Transportation, Division of Highways, acting as lead agency has prepared a negative declaration which was filed June 21, 1974, and has determined that the project will not have a significant effect on the environment.

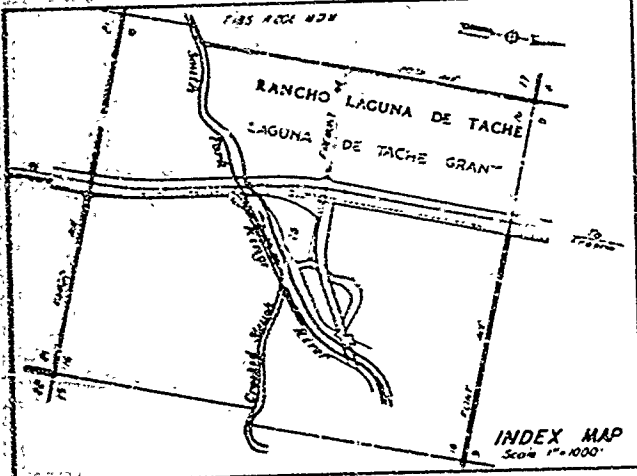

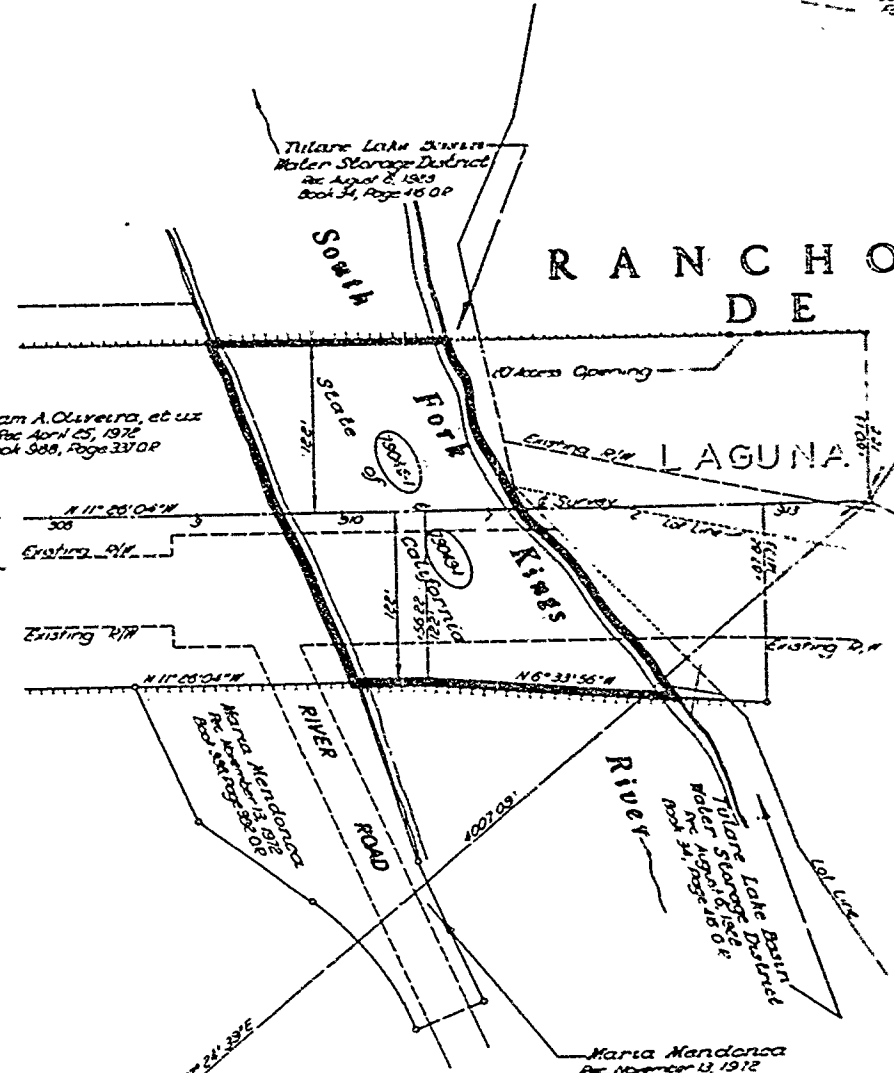
