AUTHORIZATION TO CONDUCT PUBLIC INFORMATION SESSIONS

On July 11 and 12, 1975, staff of the State Lands Division conducted public meetings at Donner Lake to present the results of the State boundary investigation. During the meetings, members of the public asked staff for explanations for tree stumps below the present water surface of the lake and for various lake surface elevations shown on old maps.

At the October 29, 1975 Commission meeting, the Commission authorized the Executive Officer to contract with Earth Satellite Corporation (Earth Sat) of Berkeley for investigation of the submerged stumps in Donner Lake. The findings of this investigation are now available. Staff investigation of maps and other evidence has also been completed. The staff proposes to conduct additional public meetings to present these findings for discussion.
