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AUTHORIZATION TO TERMINATE LEASE PRC 5050.1 AND ACCEPT QUITCLAIM DEED

BACKGROUND:

By Lease PRC 5050.1 dated November 4, 1975, Phillips Petroleum Company was Teased a 0.589 acre pancel of tide and submerged land in the bed of the Sacramento River in the City of Sacramento, Sacramento County for maintenance of an existing whous for petroleum products. Subsequently assigned to Lion Oil Company, a subsidiary of The Oil Shale Company (TOSCO) as authorized by the State Lands Commission at its meeting on February 26, 1976.

CURRENT SITUATION: Lion Oil Company has requested that the lease be terminated. The existing wharf has been removed and staff has inspected the site for clearance. In accordance with terms of the lease, Lion Oil Company has executed and delivered a quitclaim deed covering the leased area.
