31. HELICOPTER SERVICES CONTRACT - CONDOR HELICOPTERS
AND AVIATION, INCORPORATION - W 9656.

HELICOPTER SERVICES CONTRACT

The State Lands Division has contracted annually for helicopter services in the Santa Barbara area. The purpose of the contract is to have available helicopter services in the Santa Barbara Channel for observing the activities in the Channel as well as to make it possible for unscheduled inspections of offshore drilling and production structures to insure compliance by the lessees with the Commission's rules and regulations.

In accordance with Section 3.0, of existing Helicopter Services Contract LC 6022 with Condor Helicopters and Aviation, Incorporated, the State may, on or before June 30, 1977, elect to renew the agreement for a term and for consideration as the parties agree upon. The original agreement for fiscal year 1976-1977 provided for specified flight services in the total amount of \$4,010. Condor Helicopters has agreed to extend the terms of the original contract for an additional year, from July 1, 1977 through June 30, 1978, for the same total consideration - \$4,010.

IT IS RECOMMENDED THAT THE COMMISSION AUTHORIZE THE EXECUTIVE OFFICER TO EXTEND EXISTING HELICOPTER SERVICES CONTRACT LC 6022 WITH CONDOR HELICOPTERS AND AVIATION, INCORPORATED, FOR AN ADDITIONAL ONE YEAR PERIOD FROM JULY 1, 1977 THROUGH JUNE 30, 1978, AT A TOTAL COST OF \$4,010.
