PARTIAL SETTLEMENT OF OFFSHORE BOUNDARY

W 4721.1

This item has been calendared to obtain State Lands Commission approval of a partial settlement of the Federal-State offshore boundary which has been the subject of dispute in the United States v. California litigation since 1966. The United States posed to a settlement of the matters contained in a proposed second supplemental decree. If the State Lands Commission of California's ownership of approximately 5,000 additional least 3,000 acres involved in this settlement are located off the coast of California. At the coast of Southern California and in areas thought to have high potential for oil development. From an environmental in Federal Lease Sale No. 48 further seaward from California's terms of the proposed second supplemental decree, the Attorney States will prepare and file with the United States Supreme mental decree.

IT IS RECOMMENDED THAT THE STATE LANDS COMMISSION APPROVE THE PROPOSED SECOND SUPPLEMENTAL DECREE AND AUTHORIZE THE ATTORNEY GENERAL TO TAKE ALL STEPS NECESSARY TO SECURE THE ENTRY OF THIS SUPPLEMENTAL DECREE BY THE UNITED STATES SUPREME COURT.
