GENTRAL PERMIT PUBLIC AGENCY USE

APPLICANT:

County of El Dorado

300 Fair Lane

Placerville, California 95667

AREA, TYPE LAND AND LOCATION:

Discretionary sites of submerged lands in Lake Tahoe situated within El Dorado County.

LAND USE:

For the discretionary installment, maintenance and removal of hazard marker buoys necessary to identify navigational hazards or hazardous areas.

TERMS OF PROPOSED PERMIT:

Initial period: 49 years from June 1, 1977.

Special: 1. The standard covenants unrelated to functions of a public agency have been deleted from the permit.

- 2. The permit is conditioned on permittee's. conformance with the Tahoe Regional Planning Agency's Shorezone Ordinance.
- 3. Permittee agrees to give notice that the State Lands Commission has contributed the land utilized.

CONSIDERATION:

The public health and safety, with the State reserving the right at any time to set a monetary rental if the Commission finds such action to be in the State's best interest.

PREREQUISITE TERMS, FEES AND EXPENSES:

Applicant is a regulatory agency vested with the jurisdiction to exercise this function.

Payment of the required expense deposit has not been received. As a valuable and continuous public benefit will be provided by this activity, it is deemed to be in the best interest of the Statecto waive this requirement.
