LAND USE:

Right of way for one existing and one proposed submarine teléphone cable.

TERMS OF PROPOSED LEASE!

Initial period: Continuous use plus I year from

March 1, 1977.

CONSIDERATION: Specials Exempt by law, Section 7901, Public Utilities Code.

PREREQUISTTE TERMS, PEES AND EXPENSES:

Applicant is permittee of upland.
