GENERAL LEASE - RIGHT OF ENTRY,
STATE SCHOOL LAND IN SEA OF SECTION 16, T24S, R38E, M.D.M., INYO COUNTY

APPLICANTS:

Southern California Edison Company and Louisiana - Pacific Corporation, as

co-applicants.

BOCATION:

On east side of U.S. Highway 395, approximately 64 miles south of Little Lake in southern Inyo County.

TERM:

One year from May 26, 1977, or earlier termination upon Commission authorization of the Amendment and Assignment of Lease PRC 4511.2 presently being processed, whichever occurs first.

CONSIDERATION

Consideration is covered in rental under PRC 4511.2.

STATUTORY AND OTHER REFERENCES:

a. Public Résources Code: Div. 6, Parts 1 & 2.

b. Administrative Code: Title 2, Div. 3, Arts. 1, 2, 10 and 11.

OTHER PERTINENT INFORMATION:

1. On December 14, 1976, California Regional Nater Quality Control Board, Lahontan Region, adopted Board Order No. 6-76:131, concerning wastewater discharge requirements on the Louisiana-Pacific Comporation lumber mill located approximately 61 miles south of Little Lake in Inyo County on State school lands.

The Board found that run-off from the log deck system was not in compliance with the requirements that water is to be discharged only into sealed ponds to prevent exfiltration of waste.

Louisiana-Pacific Corporation has complied with design requirements; however, the system cannot be operationad until electrical

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service is provided. In order to comply with the Board's July 1, 1977 deadline, electrical service must be installed immediately, thus requiring a right of entry for power line construction.

The Amendment and Assignment covering this transaction is currently being processed by the Southern California Edison Company; however, it is anticipated that executed documents will not be received by the State Lands Division until the month of June, 1977. Fees for the right-of-way will be collected as part of this transaction.

- 2. This activity is not subject to the environmental impact requirements of CEQA in that it is exempt under Article 10, Section 2007, reference to CEQA Guidelines Section 15104 and 15111, 14 Cal. Adm. Code.
- Resources Code, the State Lands Division has found that the school land in this mentally significant and is not classified in a significant use category.

- 2. FIND THAT THERE HAS BEEN NO NOMINATIONS TO THIS PARCEL AND FROM AVAILABLE INFORMATION TO STATE LANDS STAFF, THERE IS MADE PART OF THE SIGNIFICANT LANDS REPORT.
- 3. AUTHORIZE THE ISSUANCE TO SOUTHERN CALIFORNIA EDISON COMPANY AND LOUISIANA-PACEFIC CORPORATION OF A TEMPORARY RIGHT OF ENTRY PERMIT TO COMMENCE MAY 26, 1977 AND TERMINATE WITHIN ONE YEAR OR UPON CONSUMMATION OF PENDING AMENDMENT AND

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ASSIGNMENT OF LEASE PRC 4511.2 WITH THE CONSIDERATION COVERED UNDER PRC 4511.2, FOR A RIGHT-OF-WAY APPROXIMATELY 10 FEET IN WIDTH AND 750 FEET IN LENGTH IN INYO COUNTY ON THE LAND DESCRIBED ON EXHIBIT "A" ATTACHED AND BY REFERENCE MADE A PART HEREOF.

WP 4511

A strip of land, 10 feet in width, lying within the southeast quarter (SE 1/4) of Section 16, T24s, R38E, MDE3M. The centerline of said 10-foot wide strip of land is described as follows:
