BOUNDARY LINE AGREEMENT 156

The staff of the Division was contacted concerning a boundary line agreement by attorney O. M. Lloyd, who represents four upland property owners along the Colorado River, south of Blythe in the Davis Lake area. The parcels owned by these property owners front on an area of the Colorado River which is no longer in a natural state. The property owners interest in this agreement was stimulated by the Division's Davis Lake area project work in the area.

At the October 28, 1975, Commission meeting, the Davis Lake Boundary Study and administrative maps for the area were approved. The boundary proposed for this agreement is identical to the corresponding line shown on the approved administrative maps. The Division has surveyed and monumented this line.

The Boundary Line Agreement, embodying the torogoing is on file in the office of the State Lands Commission.

The agreement is authorized by Division 6 of the Public Resources Code. It is exempt from Environmental Impact Reports required by CEQA and Section 6371 of the Public Resources Code in that it is a boundary and property settlement.

- AUTHORIZE THE STAFF OF THE STATE LANDS DIVISION AND/OR THE OFFICE OF THE ATTORNEY GENERAL TO "AKE ALL STEPS NECESSARY, INCLUDING LITIGATION, IN ORDER TO CARRY OUT THE PROVESIONS OF THIS AGREEMENT.
