AUTHORIZATION FOR DISCUALMER

The State Lands Commission is a party to a condemnation action brought by the United States, entitled United States v. 440 Acres of Land, More of Less, filed in the United States States District Court, Eastern District of California, States District Court, involving land in Calaveras County. A temporary easement for the purpose of surveying the locat A temporary easement for the purpose of surveying the location of an access road to Federal lands is the interest being condemned.

Upon examination of the Commission's records pertinent to the area, it was ascertained that the proposed easement concerns a parcel of land, 440 acres, more or less, located within the East half of the Southeast quarter of Section 21; the North half of the Southwest quarter, the Southeast quarter of the Southwest quarter and the South half of the Southeast quarter of Section 22; the North half of the Northeast quarter of the Southeast quarter of the Northeast quarter of the Northeast quarter of the Northeast quarter of Section 28 Northeast quarter of North, Range 14 East, Mount Diablo Base all in Township 6 North, Range 14 East, Mount Diablo Base and Meridian. The Licking Fork of the Molelumne River crosses through the subject parcel at a point well above the statutory head of navigation but further research and an on site field investigation would be necessary before a definitive judgment on the issue of state ownership could be made.

Because the interest to be taken in this instance is only a temporary easement for which compensation would be minimal (assuming that a fee interest in the State were found), the expense of additional investigation necessary for an informed determination on navigability would not appear to be justified.

Accordingly, it is proposed that the Commission dischaim any right to compensation without disclaiming any ownership interest which it may have in a portion of the land subject to the temporary easement.
