C4: RESCISSION OF PRIOR AUTHORIZATION TO ISSUE PRC 5288.9;
W 21477; COUNTY OF EL DORADO, GENERAL PERMIT, PUBLIC AGENCY
USE.

During consideration of Calendar Item C4 attached, the
following statement was read into the record:

The Division will continue working with the County in coop-
eratively identifying those navigational hazards that are not
capable of being removed as part of the Commission's on-going
removal program. Efforts are continuing on securing an effec-
tive means of marking the identified hazards.

The on-going hazard removal program at Lake Tahoe is approxi-
mately 70% complete, with equipment now operating near the
El Dorado County line along the west side of the lake.
Hundreds of obstacles at some 35 locations have been removed.
Local agency cooperation for the most part has been very good.

Upon motion duly made and carried, the recommendation as
presented in Calendar Item C4 was approved by a vote of 3-0.

RESCISSION OF PRIOR AUTHORIZATION
TO ISSUE PRC 5288.9

Pursuant to the application for permit of County of El Dorado, the Commission considered and approved at its meeting of May 26, 1977 a 49-year General Permit - Public Agency Use from June 1, 1977; for the discretionary installment, maintenance and removal of hazard marker buoys necessary to identify navigational hazards or hazardous areas within the bounds of submerged lands of Lake Tahoe situated in El Dorado County.

CONSIDERATION: The public health and safety, with the Commission reserving the right to set a monetary rental at any time.

The El Dorado County Board of Supervisors found the terms of the proposed permit agreement unacceptable at their meeting of August 30, 1977 and determined to withdraw the subject application.

The objections of the County are:

1. The hold harmless clause in the standard lease forms.
2. The 49-year term is unacceptable.
3. The Land Description.

IT IS RECOMMENDED THAT THE COMMISSION:

1. DETERMINE THAT AN ENVIRONMENTAL IMPACT REPORT HAS NOT BEEN PREPARED FOR THIS ACTIVITY AS SUCH REPORT IS NOT REQUIRED UNDER THE PROVISIONS OF PRC 21085, 14 CAL. ADM. CODE 15100 ET SEQ., AND 2 CAL. ADM. CODE 2907.
2. FIND THAT RESCINDING THE PERMIT WILL HAVE NO SIGNIFICANT EFFECT UPON ENVIRONMENTAL CHARACTERISTICS IDENTIFIED PURSUANT TO SECTION 6370.1 OF THE PUBLIC RESOURCES CODE.
