- The applicant has applied to the State Water Quality Control Board and the San Francisco Bay Conservation and Development Commission; permits are expected shortly.

the California and Hawaiian Sugar Company, under lease PRG 5026.1. Said Company has consented to the placement of the proposed facilities.

- Another portion of the proposed permit area is disputed as to boundary and condition of title. A non-prejudicial lease (as to this portion) will be entered into by the parties.
- An Environmental Impact Report has been prepared by the West Contra Costa County Wastewater Management Agency, along with a Notice of Determination dated August 4, 1976. A staff summary for this project is actached.
 - This project is situated on State land identified as possessing significant environmental values pursuant to Public Resources Code 6370.1, and is classified in a use category. Class "C" which authorizes Multiple Use.

Staff review indicates that there will be no significant effect upon the identified environmental values. No adverse comments have been received concerning the proposed facility.
