Aminoil has entered into a lease with the surface owners with respect to the surface owner's interest, if any, in the geothermal resources. Under this lease Aminoil has been granted whatever rights this surface owner may have to develop the geothermal resources including assignment of the State lease to Aminoil. In the interim, Aminoil has acted as operator on behalf of the Lessee and now proposes to drill a well within the lease area to evaluate the geothermal potential of the parcel.
