DREDGING PERMITS

In accordance with the Commission's delegation of authority to the Executive Officer for issuance of dredging permits of 10,000 cubic yards or less, permission was granted to perform maintenance dredging on State-owned tide and submerged lands in Humboldt Bay and submerged lands in Lake Tahoe to the following:

Louisiana Pacific Corporation, P. O. Box 158, Samoa, California 95564, Humboldt County; 7,500 cubic yards; spoils to be placed upon United States Army Corps of Engineers surf zone disposal site 17 at a charge of \$0.15 per cubic yard and private upland property at a charge of \$0.25 per cubic yard; permit expires March 30, 1979.

Mr. William F. Dondero, Sunnyside Tahoe Properties, P. O. Box 252, Tahoe City, California 95730, Placer County; 2,000 cubic yards; spoils to be placed upon privately owned uplands at a charge of \$0.25 per cubic yard; permit expires April 30, 1979.

A parcel of submerged land in Lake Tahoe, Placer County, California, more particularly described as follows:

That certain parcel of land within an existing small craft marina, together with a necessary use area, fronting upon Lots 1, 2, 5, 6 and the northerly 50 feet of Lot 3 as said lots are shown on "Map No. 2 Sunnyside", filed March 4, 1935 in Book "D" of Maps, at Page 53, Placer County Records.

EXCEPTING THEREFROM any portion lying landward of the ordinary high water mark of Lake Tahoe.

A rectangular parcel of tide and submerged land 679.28 feet long and 100 feet wide in Humboldt Bay, City of Eureka, Humboldt County, California, the southeasterly line of said parcel being the northwesterly edge of Louisiana Pacific Corporation, Humboldt Lock A, and the extensions of said edge, the southwesterly line of said parcel lies southwesterly 150 feet from and parallel with the southwesterly edge of said dock.

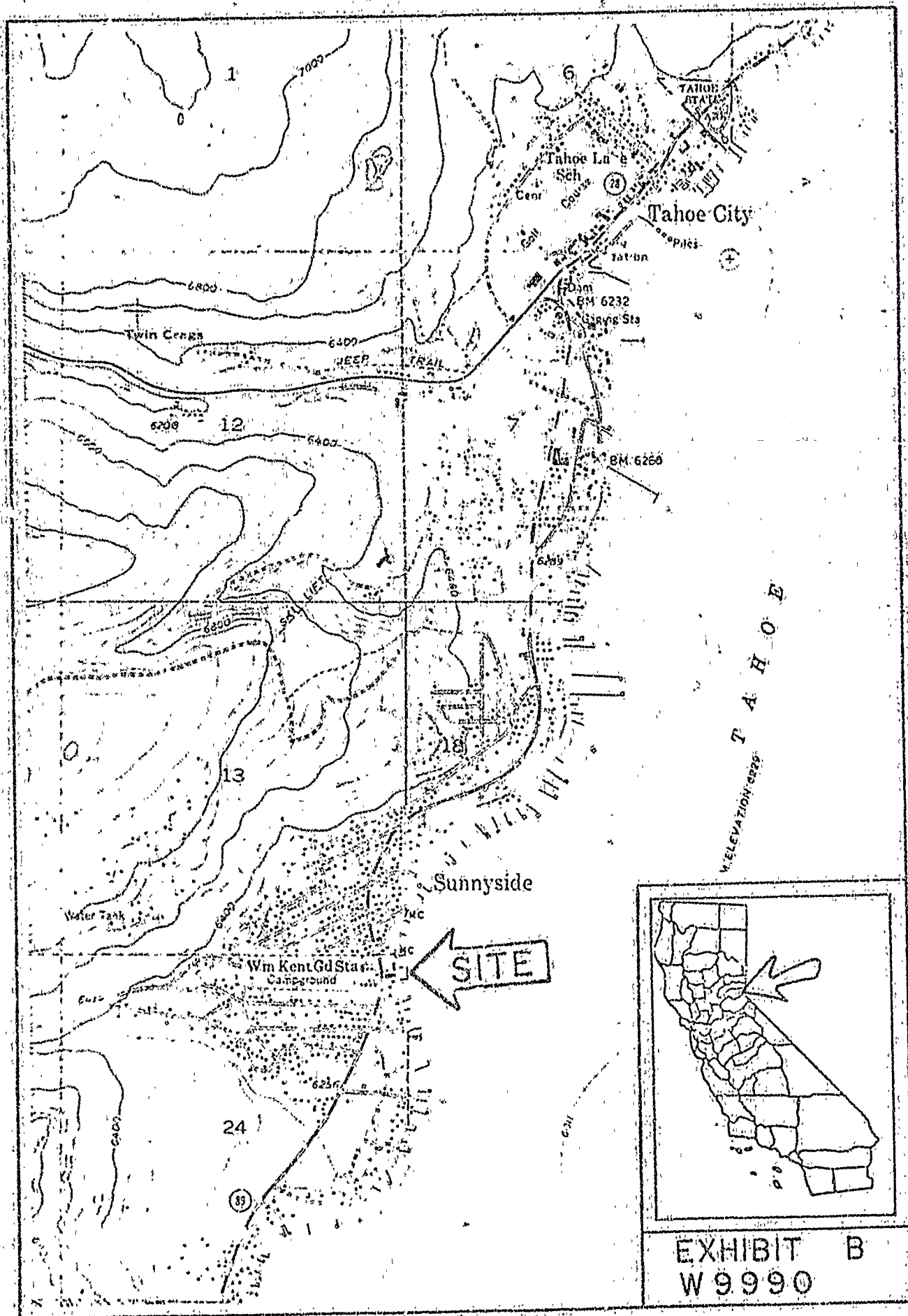
