GENERAL PERMIT
PUBLIC AGENCY USE

APPLICANT: Scripps Institution of Oceanography
University of California
A-027
La Jolla, California 92093

AREA, TYPE LAND AND LOCATION:
A parcel of tide and submerged land in
the Pacific Ocean at Shelter Cove, Humboldt
County.

LAND USE: Tide Monitoring Gauge.

TERMS OF PROPOSED PERMIT:
Initial period: 49 years from January 1,
1978.

CONSIDERATION: The public use and benefit.

PREREQUISITE TERMS, FEES AND EXPENSES:
Applicant is permittee of upland.

STATUTORY AND OTHER REFERENCES:
A. Public Resources Code: Div. 6, Parts 1 & 2.
B. Administrative Code: Title 2, Div. 3,
Arts. 1, 2, 0.5,
10 & 11.

OTHER PERTINENT INFORMATION:
1. The annual rental value of the site
is estimated to be \$100.
2. This project is exempt from CEQA because
the project involves the placement
of a water current tidal monitoring
device.

3. This project is consistent with Article 6.5 because it involves data gathering activities which are not considered development within the meaning of the coastal guidelines.
4. This project is situated on State land identified as possessing significant environmental values pursuant to Public Resources Code 6307.1, and is classified in a use category, Class A which authorizes Restricted Use.

Staff has coordinated this project with those agencies and organizations who nominated the site as containing significant environmental values. They have found this project to be compatible with their nomination.

IT IS RECOMMENDED THAT THE COMMISSION:

1. DETERMINE THAT AN EIR HAS NOT BEEN PREPARED FOR THIS ACTIVITY AS SUCH REPORT IS NOT REQUIRED UNDER THE PROVISIONS OF P.R.C. 21085, 14 CAL. ADM. CODE 15100 ET SEQ., AND 2 CAL. ADM. CODE 2907.
2. DETERMINE THAT THE PROJECT IS CONSISTENT WITH THE PROVISIONS OF ARTICLE 6.5 OF TITLE 2 OF THE CALIFORNIA ADMINISTRATIVE CODE.
3. FIND THAT GRANTING OF THE PERMIT WILL HAVE NO SIGNIFICANT EFFECT UPON ENVIRONMENTAL CHARACTERISTICS IDENTIFIED PURSUANT TO SECTION 6370.1, OF THE PUBLIC RESOURCES CODE.
4. AUTHORIZE ISSUANCE TO SCRIPPS INSTITUTION OF OCEANOGRAPHY, UNIVERSITY OF CALIFORNIA OF A 49-YEAR GENERAL PERMIT - PUBLIC AGENCY USE; IN CONSIDERATION OF THE PUBLIC USE AND BENEFIT FOR OPERATION AND MAINTENANCE OF AN EXISTING TIDE MONITORING GAUGE ON THE LAND DESCRIBED ON EXHIBIT "A" ATTACHED AND BY REFERENCE MADE A PART HEREOF.

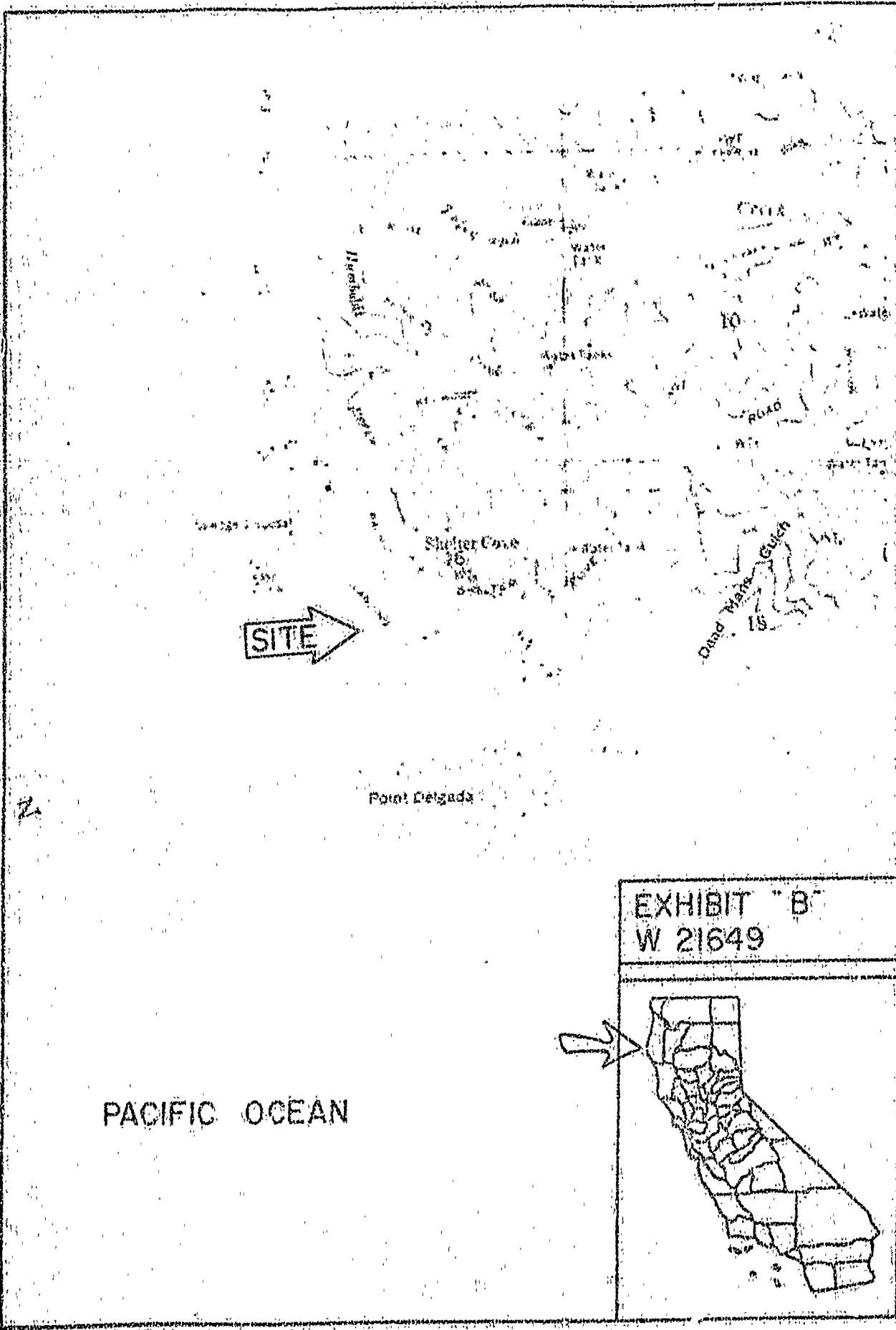
