AUTHORIZATION TO FILE DISCLAIMER IN UNITED STATES
OF AMERICA V. 15.58 ACRES OF LAND, MORE OR LESS,
ET AL., UNITED STATES DISTRICT COURT, EASTERN
DISTRICT OF CALIFORNIA, CIVIL NO. F-77-230

The State Lands Commission is a party to a United States condemnation action brought by the United States Attorney entitled, United States of America v. 15.58 acres of land, more or less, etc., et al., filed in the United States District Court, Eastern District of California, Civil No. F-77-230 involving land in Mariposa County to be used in connection with the administration, preservation and development of Yosemite National Park for the use, benefit and enjoyment of the public.

Upon examination of the Commission's records pertinent to the area, it has been ascertained that there is no interest held by the State Lands Commission as to the tract of land described in the notice of condemnation.

Inasmuch as this suit involves land over which the Commission has no jurisdiction, it is recommended that a disclaimer be filed on behalf of the State Lands Commission disclaiming any compensable right, title or interest in the tract of the subject condemnation.

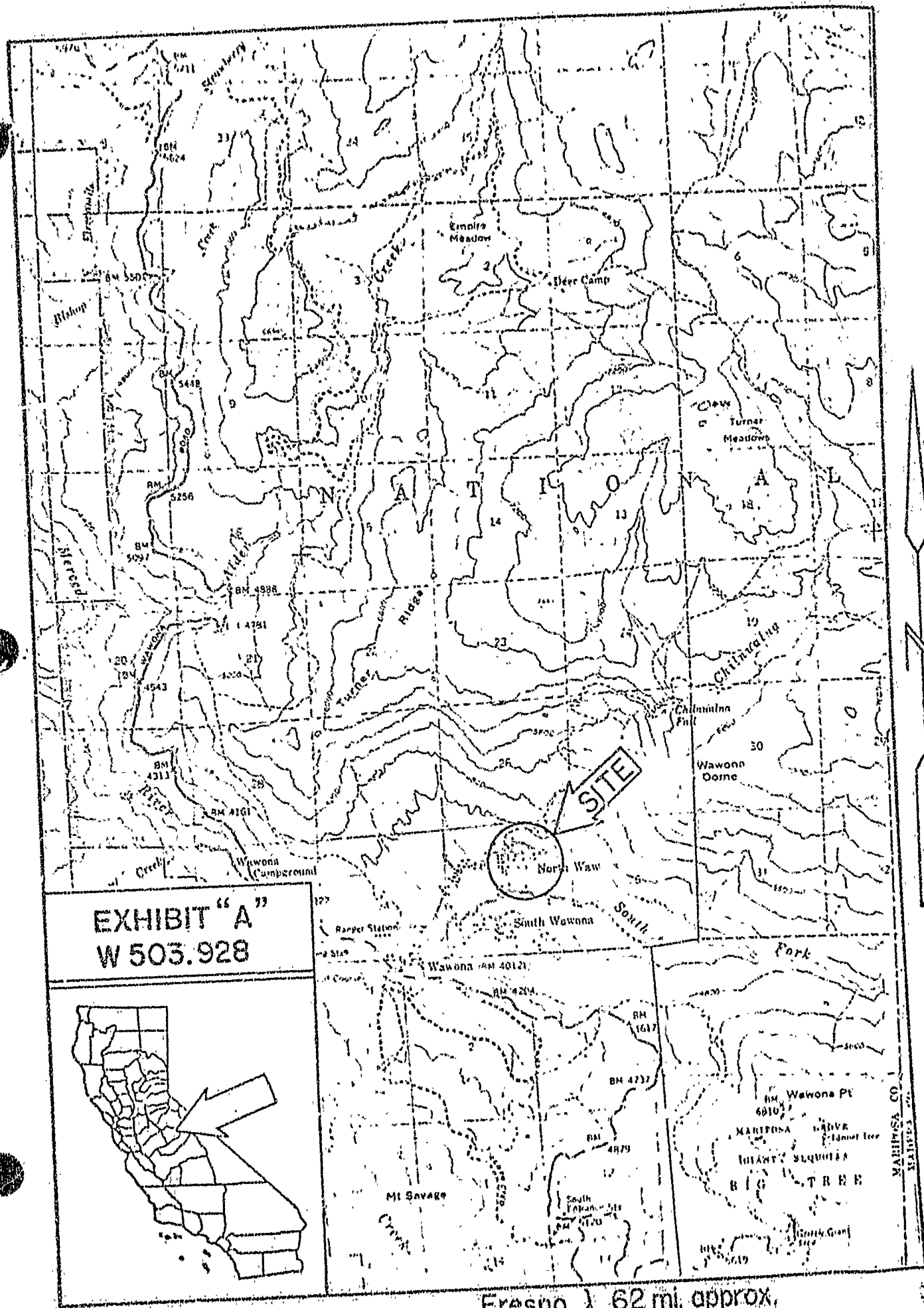
