BACKGROUND:

At its meeting of August 26, 1976 the Commission authorized the issuance to Cyril G. Fairley of a 25-year General Permit, Protective Structure beginning September 1, 1976 for the construction of rock riprap bank protection on a parcel of land on the Sacramento River off Garden Highway, Sacramento County. Staff prepared an environmental document for the proposed activity and submitted a negative declaration to the Commission for its approval along with the proposed permit.

CURRENT SITUATION:

The proposed permit was never executed by the applicant. During processing of this permit, the subject upland parcel was acquired by the County of S. cramento by Grant Deed dated June 23, 1977. Staff visited the site of the proposed bank protection project on March 1, 1979 and found no evidence that the proposed bank protection project had been started. Mr. Fairley has not responded to staff correspondence, and is no longer the upland owner.
