RECISSION OF GENERAL PERMIT PRC 4649 AND ISSUANCE OF A LO-YEAR GENERAL PERMIT RECREATIONAL USE

AREA, TYPE LAND AND LOCATION:

A 0.017 acre parcel (736 square feet) of submergid land in the Sacramento River near Hamilton City, Tehama County.

LAND USE:

Existing boat dock and walkway for recreational

purposes.

TERMS OF OFIGINAL PERMIT:

5 years from March 1, 1977. Initial period:

Surety bond:

\$1,000.

Consideration: \$30 per annum.

TERMS OF PROPOSED PERMIT:

Initial period:

10 years from March 1, 1977.

Public liability insurance: Combined single

limit coverage of \$100,000

for bodily injury and

property damage.

\$30 per annum, with the State reserving CONSIDERATION: the right to fix a different rental on

each fifth anniversary of the permit.

BASIS FOR CONSIDERATION:

\$30 fixed rental for this type of permit.

PREREQUISITE TERMS, FEES AND EXPENSES:

Applicant is permittee of upland.

Filing fee and first year's rent have been

received.

OTHER PERTINENT INFORMATION:

- 1. Applicant does not qualify for a rent-free recreational pier permit in that he does not own the upland immediately adjacent to the Sacramento River, but does, in the staff's opinion, qualify for the permit as recommended.
- 2. An EIR is not required. This transaction is within the purview of 2 Cal. Adm. Code 2907, Class 1(B), which exempts an existing structure or facility that is in an acceptable state of repair and there is no evidence of record to show injury to adjacent property, shoreline erosion, or ther types of environmental degradation.
- This project is situated on State land identified as possessing significant environmental values pursuant to P.R.C. 6370.1, and is classified in a use category, Class B, which authorizes Limited Use.

Staff review indicates that there will he no significant effect upon the identified environmental values. This is an existing facility for which no adverse comments have been received.

LAND DESCRIPTION

WP 4649

A parcel of lar in the State-owned bed of the Sacramento River, Tehama County, California, said parcel being immediately beneath and extending 10 feet on all sides of an existing pier and walkway located adjacent to the lands of the Glen Colusa Trrigation District and easterly of that certain parcel of land described in Book 612, page 545, Official Records of Tehama County.

EXCEPTING THEREFROM any portion lying landward of the ordinary high water \overline{m} ark of the Sacramento River.
