Construction of the pier is being financed by the Wildlife Conservation Board; with the City of Rio Vista providing maintenance and security pursuant to an inter-agency agreement. Water Resources is responsible for installation and mainte ance of the water quality monitoring facility. The primary purpose of the pier is to provide a public fishing facility,

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
