GENERAL PERMIT PUBLIC AGENCY USE

APPLICANT:

United States Department of Agriculture Forest Service P. O. Box 8465. South Lake Tahoe, California 95731

AREA, TYPE LAND AND LOCATION: Two 0.029 acre circular parcels, 40 feet in diameter, of submerged land at Valhalla Estates, near South Lake Tahoe, El Dorado County's

LAND USE:

Maintenance of 2 existing multiple-use public recreational mooring buoys.

TERMS OF PROPOSED PERMIT:

Initial period:

42 years from August 3, 1978.

Public Tiability insurance: Combined single limit coverage of \$300,000 for bodily injury and property damage.

Special:

- 1. Staff counsel has approved the deletion of those standard covenants unrelated to functions of a public agency.
- 2. Staff counsel has approved the revision of wording of certain standard covenants relative to the jurisdiction and laws of the United States.
 - 3. The permit is conditioned on permittee's conformance with the Tahoe Regional Planning Agency's Shorezone Ordinance.

4. Permittee agrees to post notice that the State Lands Commission has contributed a portion of the land utilized by the facility:

CONSIDERATION: The public use and benefit, with the State reserving the right at any time to set a monetary rental if the Commission finds such action to be in the State's best interest.

BASIS FOR CONSIDERATION:
2 Cal. Adm. Code 2005.

PRÈREQUISITE TERMS AND EXPENSES:

Applicant is owner of upland.

Filing fee and processing costs will be received prior to issuance of the permit.

STATUTORY AND OTHER REFERENCES:

A. P.R.C.: Div. 6: Parts 1 & 2.

B. Cal. Adm. Code: Title 2, Div. 3.

OTHER PERTINENT INFORMATION:

- 1. The annual rental value of the site is estimated to be \$60.
- 2. The Commission at its meeting on November 27, 1978 suspended all leasing for new construction at Lake Tahee, except for mooring buoys in designated areas and other multiple-use facilities. This action was taken pending completion of an EIR which addresse the cumulative impact of continued construction of piers in Lake Tahoe. The facilities herein are for the continued use of existing buoys in the lake, and therefore are not subject to the Commission's suspension of leasing activities for new construction.

- 3. An EIR is not required. This transaction is within the purview of 2 Cal. Adm. Code 2907(B) which exempts an existing structure or facility that is in an acceptable state of repair and there is no evidence of record to show injury to adjacent property, shoreline erosion, or other types of environmental degradation.
- 4. This project is situated on State land identified as possessing significant environmental values pursuant to P.R.C. 6370.1, and is classified in a use category, Class B, which authorized limited Use.

Staff review indicates that there will be no significant effect upon the identifed environmental values. This is an existing facility for which no adverse comments have been received.

APPROVALS REQUIRED AND OBTAINED:

This facility is subject to the jurisdiction of the Tahoe Regional Planning Agency, United States Army Corps of Engineers, California Department of Fish and Game, Lahontan Regional Water Quality Control Board, and the County of El Dorado. The proposed permit is conditioned on the approval of all agencies having jurisdiction.
