MODIFICATION MAINTENANCE DREDGING PERMIT PRC 4975.9

APPLICANT:

Union Oil Company of California San Francisco Refinery Rodéo, California 94572

AREA, TYPE LAND AND LOCATION:

State-owned tide and submerged lands in San Pablo Bay at Davis Point, Contra Costa-County.

RESUME OF PREVIOUS ACTION:

The Commission on November 21, 1974, authorized issue of dredging permit PRC 4975.9 to the applicant effective November 21, 1974 through December 31, 1979, for maintenance dredging of a maximum of 450,000 cubic yards of material at an annual rate of 90,000 cubic yards from the applicants wharf area at Davis Boint, in San Pablo Bay, Contra Costa County, with spoils to be deposited in Corps of Engineers disposal sites. The project was determined to be exempt from the requirements of CEQA.

PROPOSED MODIFICATION:

- 1. Extend the effective date of Dredging Permit PRC 4975.9 from January 1, 1980, through December 31, 1989, for a maximum of 900,000 cubic yards at an average annual rate of 90,000 cubic yards.
- Add Parcel 4, an area approximately 100 x 150 feet at the refinery's cooling water inlet, to the areas to be dredged.
- 3. Assess a royalty of \$0.15 per cubic yard for materials removed from State lands and deposited in United States Army Corps of Engineers disposal sites, and provide for annual adjustment of royalty rates.
- 4. Incorporate a provision assessing statutory

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penalties for failure to pay secrued royalties when due.

5. Because of the extent of modifications proposed, the entire permit has been rewritten in current permit format.

CONSIDERATION: A royalty of \$0.15 per cubic yard for materials

removed from State lands and spoiled into

authorized disposal sites.

- 1. DETERMINE THAT AN EIR HAS NOT BEEN PREPARED FOR THIS PROJECT AS SUCH REPORT IS NOT REQUIRED UNDER PROVISIONS OF P.R.C. 21085, 14 CAL. ADM. CODE 15100 ET SEQ. AND 2 CAL. ADM. CODE 2907, CLASS 4, WHICH CATEGORICALLY EXEMPT MAINTENANCE DREDGING OPERATIONS.
- 2. FIND THAT GRANTING OF THE PERMIT EXTENSION WILL HAVE NO SIGNIFICANT EFFECT UPON ENVIRONMENTAL CHARACTERISTICS IDENTIFIED PURSUANT TO SECTION 6370.1 OF THE P.R.C.
- 3. AUTHORIZE THE EXTENSION OF DREDGING PERMIT PRC 4975.9
 TO UNION OIL COMPANY OF CALIFORNIA FROM JANUARY 1,
 1980 THROUGH DECEMBER 31, 1989, WITH THE ADDITION OF
 A PARCEL 4 AS DESCRIBED IN THE PERMIT TO THE AREA TO
 BE DREDGED, AND PROVISIONS FOR PAYMENT OF ROYALTIES,
 AND MODIFICATION OF REFORTING REQUIREMENTS; SUCH PERMISSION
 BEING CONTINGENT UPON APPLICANTS COMPLIANCE WITH APPLICABLE
 PERMITS, RECOMMENDATIONS OR LIMITATIONS ISSUED BY FEDERAL,
 STATE AND LOCAL GOVERNMENTAL AGENCIES.
