A 42.33 acres, more or less, tide and submerged

land, Carquinez Strait, Martinez, Contra

Costa County.

LAND USE:

Natural shoreline park.

TERMS OF PROPOSED PERMIT:

Initial period: 49 years from December 20,

1979.

CONSIDERATION:

Public use and benefic, with the State reserving the right at any time to set a monetary rental if the Commission finds

such action to be in the State's best interest.

BASIS FOR CONSIDERATION:

2 Cal. Adm. Code 2005.

PREREQUISITE TERMS, FEES AND EXPENSES:

Applicant is permittee, of upland.

Filing fee and processing costs have been received.

STATUTORY AND OTHER REFERENCES:

OTHER PERTINENT INFORMATION:

- 1. The annual rental value of the site is estimated to be \$3200.
- 2. This activity is exempt from CEQA because it consists of an action by a regulatory agency for protection of the environment.

- The State property to be placed under permit will remain in its natural state. It will serve as a visual amenity and as a natural waterfowl area. A portion of the adjacent land, owned by Shell Oil, will be utilized as a pedestrian trail; the applicant negotiated an easement for such use on the Shell property.
- This project is situated on State land identified as possessing significant evironmental values pursuant to P.R.C. 6370.1 and is classified in a use category, class "C", which authorizes Multiple Üse.

Staff review indicates that there will be no significant effect upon the identified environmental values.

DESCRIPTION OF PROPOSED LEASE OF STATE LANDS TO EAST BAY REGIONAL PARK DISTRICT

A portion of State Submerged Lands, Contra Costa County, California, described as follows:

Beginning at a point designated as Station "G" having California Coordinate x = 1,530,439.46, y = 559,747.10, as shown on map entitled "Boundary of State Submerged Lands, Vicinity of Martinez, Contra Costa County, California", recorded June 14, 1962 in Volume 20 LSM Page 14, in Contra Costa County; thence from said Station "G" north 59° 511 8" east, 630.68 feet to a point designated as Station "H". on said map (20 LSM 14); thence north 54° 36: 29" east, 143,99 feet more or less to the point of beginning of the parcel of land described as Exhibit "C" in the "Renewal and Amendment of Lease P.R.C. 543.1" between the State of California and Shell Oil Company, filed June 6, 1974 in Volume 7243 at page 476, Official Records of Contra Costa County; thence along said lease line (7243 or 476) north 7° 331 311 west, 844.02 feet; south 58° 16' 45" west, 274 feet; north 7° 33' 31" west 930 feet, and south 58° 16' 45" west, 1,210 feet; thence south 9° 42' 07" west, 494.57 feet to a point on the northerly line of the percel of land granted to the East Bay Regional Park District in State of California Senate Bill 1875, Section 15, statutes of 1976; thence along the boundary of said East Bay Regional Park District lands, south 81° 03; 30" easz 510.00 feet and south 26° 56; 14" east, 910.37 feet to the point of beginning.
