CESSION OF CONCURRENT CRIMINAL JURISDICTION .

The United States Army through the United States Army Corps of Engineers has applied for a cession of concurrent criminal jurisdiction pursuant to Government Code 126. The subject parcel is a section of 14th Street, Oakland, California which runs through the Oakland Army Base. The Army has recently acquired fee title to the street from the City of Oakland. Because of law enforcement difficulties the Army desires a cession of concurrent criminal jurisdiction to resolve the problem. The entire base except for this parcel was put under concurrent jurisdiction in 1976.

IT IS RECOMMENDED THAT THE COMMISSION AUTHORIZE STAFF TO CONDUCT A PUBLIC HEARING PURSUANT TO GOVERNMENT CODE 126 TO RECEIVE INFORMATION RELATIVE TO THE PROPOSED CESSION OF JURISDICTION.

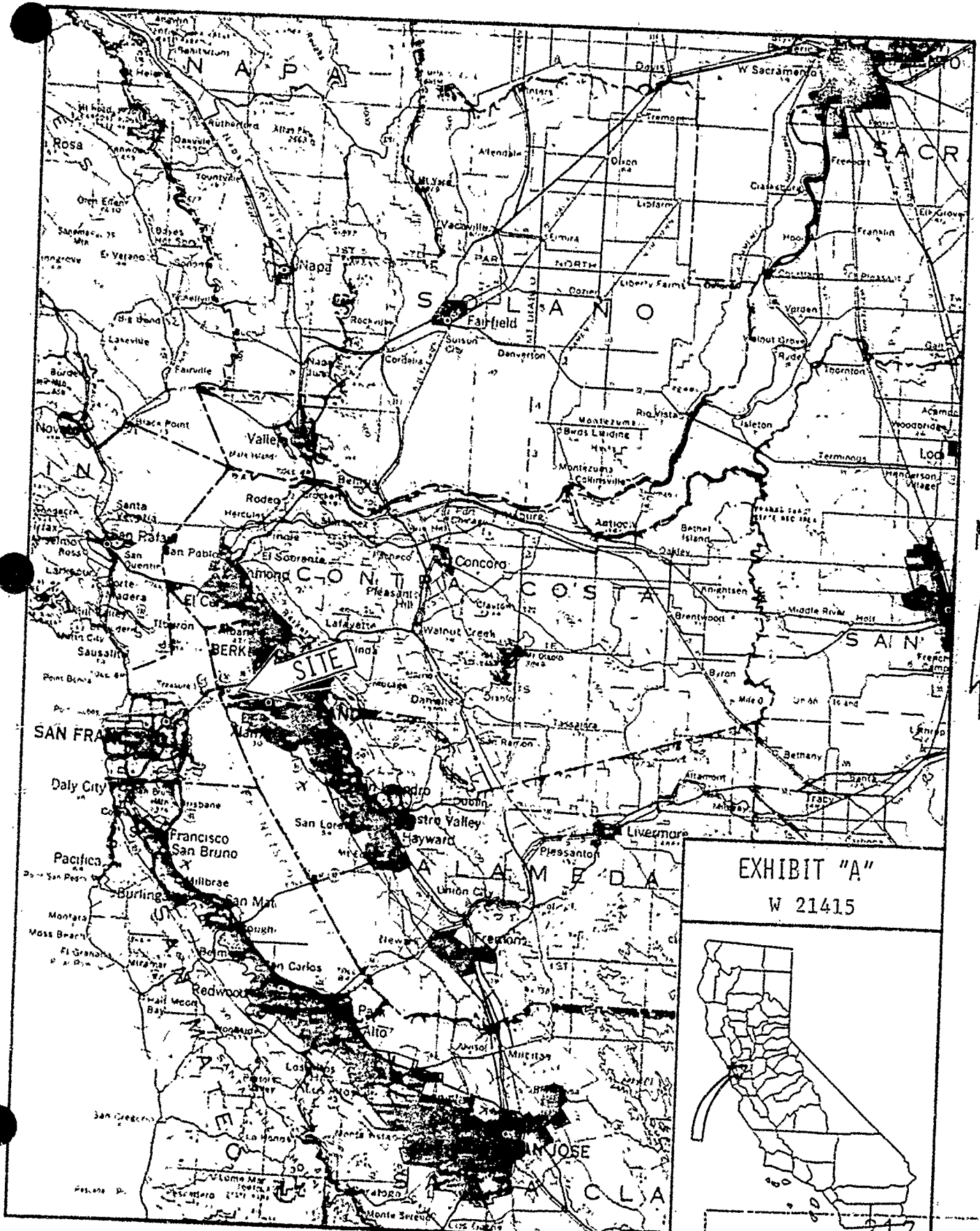
