OTHER PERTINENT INFORMATION:

- 1. An EIR is not required. This transaction is within the purview of 2 Cal. Adm. Code 2907. Class 1(B) which exempts an existing structure or facility that is in an acceptable state of repair and there is no evidence of record to show injury to adjacent property, shoreline erosion, or other types of environmental degradation.
- This project is situated on land identified as possessing environmental values in that the State Lands Commission stated all waterways under the Commission's jurisdiction have environmental significance. Staff finds this project to be compatible with Commission policy.
- The deck is attached to a residence.
 The exact location of the State's boundary is undetermined, although the residence appears to be landward of the waterline.
 The proposed permit contains non-prejudicial language as to location of State boundary.

OBERT OF A 10-YEAR GENERAL PERMIT REFEATIONAL, RESIDENTIAL USE FROM DECEMBER 1, 1979, IN CONSIDERATION OF ANNUAL RENT IN THE AMOUNT OF \$30 FOR THE MAINTENANCE OF A RESIDENTIAL DECK AND OTHER RECREATIONAL, RESIDENTIAL FACILITIES TO THE EXTENT THAT THEY ARE LOCATED ON TIDE AND SUBMERGED LAND; PROVISION OF PUBLIC LIABILITY INSURANCE IN THE AMOUNT OF \$100,000 COMBINED SINGLE LIMIT COVERAGE; AND FOR OPERATION AND MAINTENANCE OF TWO RENT FREE FLOATS AND BOAT HOIST PURSUANT TO PRC 6503.5 ON THE LAND DESCRIBED ON EXHIBIT "A" ATTACHED AND BY REFERNCE MADE A PART HEREOF.
