In accordance with the Commission's delegation of authority to the Executive Officer for issuance of temporary permits - emergency basis (Minute Item No. 21, February 28, 1980), the Executive Officer has granted permission to Wickland Oil Company to use State lands at Selby, Contra Costa County for the purpose of a slag borrow area and shipment of the slag by barge to repair delta levees (Webb Tract) damaged by this past winter's storms.

The permit will terminate June 30, 1980; provides that no permanent structures shall be erected; and requires payment of rental (the greater of \$550 or 5% of the gross receipts received by Wickland).

The project has been found by staff to meet the emergency project requirements of CEQA and Section 15071 of the State EIR Guidelines. In addition, staff has coordinated this project with nominating agencies for compatibility with identified environmental characteristics under Section 6371 et. seq. of the P.R.C.

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
