GENERAL PERMIT RECREATIONAL USE

APPLICANT:

Wayne F. Welcome 24 Arlene Court

Walnut Creek, California 94595

AREA, TYPE LAND AND LOCATION:

.005 acre of submerged land in Lake Tahoe,

Placer County.

LAND USE:

For the maintenance of an existing mooring

buoy.

TERMS OF PROPOSED PERMIT:

10 years from February 1, Initial period:

1980.

Public liability insurance: Combined single

limit coverage of \$100,000.

Special:

The permit is conditioned on the permittee's conformance with the California Tahoe Regional Planning Agency's Shore-

zone Ordinance,

\$30.00 per annum, with the State reserving CONSIDERATION:

the right to fix a different rental on each fifth anniversary of the permit.

BASIS FOR CONSIDERATION:

\$30.00 fixed rental for this type of permit.

PREREQUISITE TERMS, FEES AND EXPENSES:

Applicant is permittee of upland.

Filing fee and the first year's rental

of \$30.00 have been received.

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STATUTORY AND OTHER REFERENCES:

A. P.R.C.: Div. 6, Parts 1 & 2.

B. Cal. Adm. Code: Title 2, Div. 3.

OTHER PERTINENT INFORMATION:

- 1. An EIR is not required. This transaction is within the purview of 2 Cal. Adm. Code 2907, Class 1(B), which exempts an existing structure or facility that is in an acceptable state of repair and there is no evidence of record to show injury to adjacent property, shoreline erosion, or other types of environmental degradation.
- This project is situated on State land identified as possessing significant environmental values pursuant to P.R.C. 6370.1, and is classified in a use category, Class B, which authorizes Limited Use.

Staff review indicates that there will be no significant effect upon the identified environmental values. This is an existing facility for which no adverse comments have been received.

- November 27, 1978, suspended the granting of permits for new construction at Lake Tahoe. The application herein is for continued use of an existing buoy in the Lake, and therefore is not subject to the Commission's suspension of granting permits for new construction.
- 4. Back rent in the amount of \$107.50 covering the period between the dates of application of July 3, 1976 and the permit date of February 1, 1980 is to be waived since the delay was not the fault of the applicant but due to Administrative revisions and changes.

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IT IS RECOMMENDED THAT THE COMMISSION:

- 1. DETERMINE THAT AN EIR HAS NOT BEEN PREPARED FOR THIS ACTIVITY AS SUCH REPORT IS NOT REQUIRED UNDER THE PROVISIONS OF P.R.C. 21085, 14 CAL. ADM. CODE 15100 ET SEQ., AND 2 CAL. ADM. CODE 2907.
- 2. FIND THAT GRANTING OF THE PERMIT WILL HAVE NO SIGNIFICANT EFFECT UPON ENVIRONMENTAL CHARACTERISTICS IDENTIFIED PURSUANT TO SECTION 6370.1, OF THE P.R.C.
- 3. AUTHORIZE ISSUANCE TO WAYNE F. WELCOME OF A 10-YEAR GENERAL PERMIT RECREATIONAL USE FROM FEBRUARY 1, 1980; IN CONSIDERATION OF ANNUAL RENT IN THE AMOUNT OF \$30.00, WITH THE STATE RESERVING THE RIGHT TO FIX A DIFFERENT RENTAL ON EACH FIFTH ANNIVERSARY OF THE PERMIT; PROVISION OF PUBLIC LIABILITY INSURANCE FOR COMBINED SINGLE LIMIT COVERAGE OF \$100,000; AND WAIVER OF BACK RENT FOR MAINTENANCE OF AN EXISTING MOORING BUOY ON THE LAND DESCRIBED ON EXHIBIT "A" ATTACHED AND BY REFERENCE MADE A PART HEREOF.
