GENERAL PERMIT - RECREATIONAL USE

- APPLICANT: Newport Harbor Yacht Club 720 West Bay Avenue Balboa, California 92661
- AREA, TYPE LAND AND LOCATION: Two circular areas of submerged land containing 0.0036 acres in the Pacific Ocean, Newport Beach, Orange County.

LAND USE: Maintenance of two race marker buoys.

TERMS OF PROPOSED PERMIT: Initial period:

eriod: 10 years from May 1, 1980.

Public Liability insurance: Combined single limit coverage of \$100,000.

CONSIDERATION: \$30.00 per annum with the State reserving the right to fix a different rental on each fifth anniversary of the permit.

BASIS FOR CONSIDERATION: \$30.00 fixed rental for this type of permit.

PREREQUISITE TERMS, FEES AND EXPENSES: The marker buoy sites are located in the Pacific Ocean for which no upland owner permission is necessary.

Filing fee has been received.

STATUTORY AND OTHER REFERENCES: A. P.R.C.: Div. 6, Parts 1 & 2.

B. Cal. Adm. Code: Title 2, Div. 3.

OTHER PERTINENT INFORMATION:

1. This project is exempt from CEQA because it involves the placement of marker buoys for designating racing zones and will not affect public navigation or fishing rights.

Authority: 2 Cal. Adm. Code 2907(3E).

 This project is situated on State land identified as possessing significant environmental values pursuant to P.R.C. 6370.1, and is classified in a use category, Class C, which authorizes Multiple Use.

Staff review indicates that there will be no significant effect upon the identified environmental values. No adverse comments have been received concerning the proposed project.

- 3. The proposed marker buoys are consistent with the requirement of Article 6.5, 2 Cal. Adm. Code, in that they will not interfere with navigation or rights of the public.
- 4. This permit is conditioned on the permittee's conformance with the rules, regulations, policies or ordinances of the Army Corps of Engineers, the United States Coast Guard, the California Coastal Commission, the City of Newport Beach, or any other regulatory agency having jurisdiction in the Pacific Ocean in the vicinity of the mouth of the Santa Ana River.

To date the applicant has obtained a permit from the City of Newport Beach.
