EMERGENCY PERMIT

APPLICANT: City of Trinidad
P. O. Box Drawer "N"
Trinidad, California 95570

In accordance with the Commission's delegation of authority to the Executive Officer for issuance of Temporary Permits - Emergency Basis (Minute Item No. 21, February 28, 1980), the Executive Officer has granted permission to the City of Trinidad to use State lands at Trinidad Bay, Humboldt County for the purpose of placing approximately 40 cubic yards of rock in front of an existing exposed storm drain pipe in order to protect the pipe from wave action. Exposure of the pipe was caused by this past winter's storms.

The Temporary Permit will expire August 13, 1980. Staff will process an amendment to Lease PRC 5254.1, an existing lease granted to the City of Trinidad for seasonal installation and maintenance of 400 anchored mooring buoys and which lease area also encompasses that area covered by the Temporary Permit, to include the existing storm drain pipe and future maintenance required thereon. Approval for said amendment will be sought at a future Commission meeting.

The project has been found by staff to meet the emergency project requirements of CEQA and Section 15071 of the State EIR Guidelines. In addition, staff has coordinated this project with nominating agencies for compatibility with identified environmental characteristics under Section 6371 et. seq., of the P.R.C.

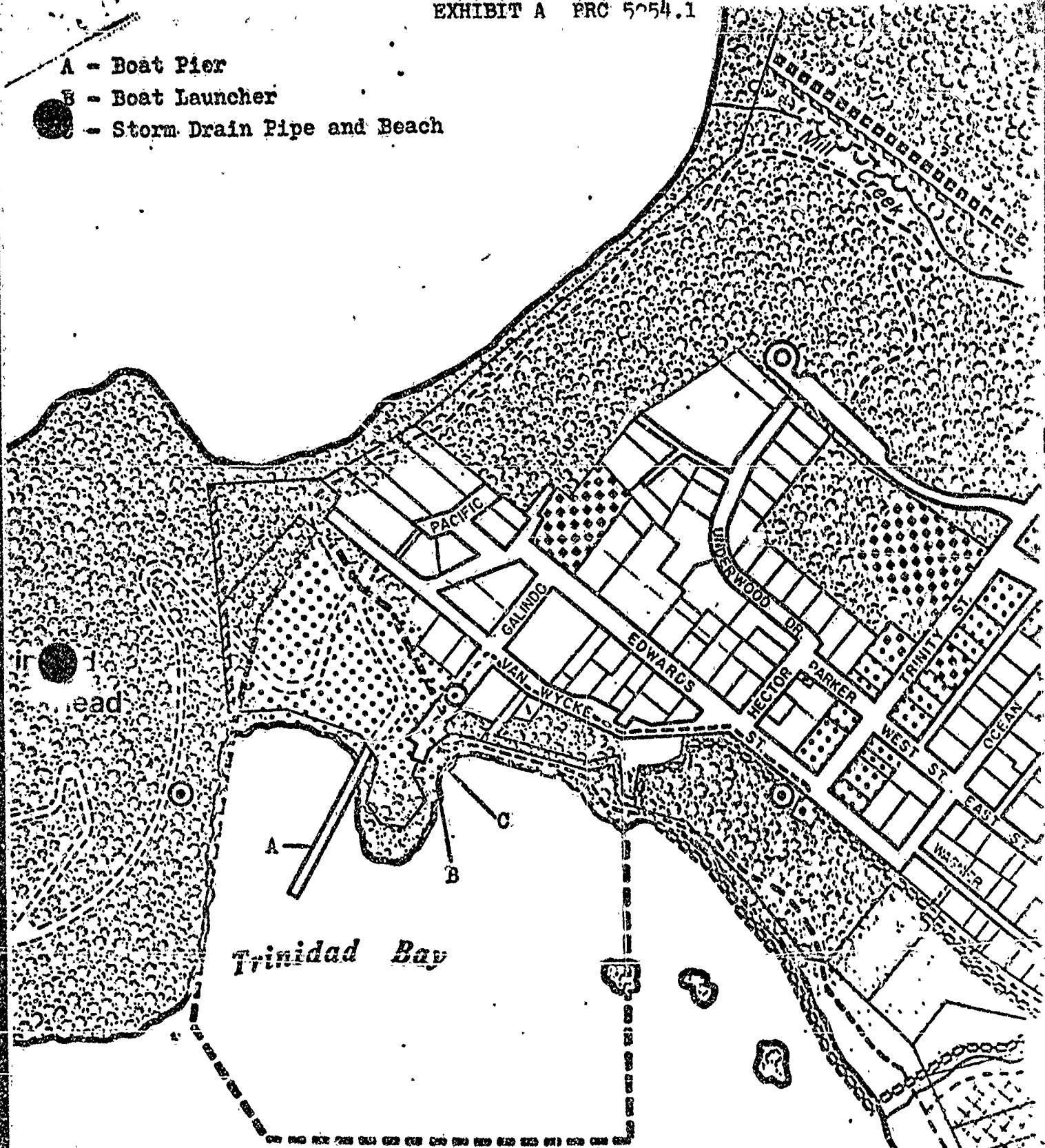
