3. This project is situated on State land identified as possessing significant environmental values pursuant to P.R.C. 6370.1. and is classified in a use category, Class B, which authorizes Limited Use.

AUTHORIZE ISSUANCE TO PHILLIP MALIK OF A 10-YEAR GENERAL PERMIT PROTECTIVE STRUCTURE USE FROM MAY 1, 1930; IN CONSIDERATION OF THE PUBLIC USE AND BENEFIT, WITH THE STATE RESERVING THE RIGHT AT ANY TIME TO SET A MONETARY RENTAL IF THE COMMISSION FINDS SUCH ACTION TO BE IN THE STATE'S BEST INTEREST, FOR THE CONSTRUCTION AND MAINTENANCE OF TWO (2) STORM WATER OUTFALL STRUCTURES AND RIPRAP BANK PROTECTION ON THE LAND DESCRIBED ON EXHIBIT "A" ATTACHED AND BY REFERENCE MADE A PART HEREOF.

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
