APPROVE PROPOSED EXPENDITURES FOR SUBSIDENCE MAINTENANCE AND REPAIRS AND SUBSIDENCE STUDIES CITY OF LONG BEACH FOR 1980-81 FISCAL YEAR

SUBSIDENCE REMEDIAL PROJECT:

Maintenance and Repairs, and Studies, July 1, 1980 to June 30, 1981.

SUBSIDENCE ELEMENTS:

A. City's Presentation:

Routine maintenance work as a result of subsidence will be required to Harbor District facilities during the 1980-81 Fiscal Year.

Subsidence studies will be performed in the same period to measure vertical and horizontal ground movements, to analyze any subsidence damage to Harbor District facilities and to initiate requests for Commission prior approval of subsidence cost expenditures.

B. Staff's Analysis:

Staff concurs with the items of subsidence work presented by the City.

COST:

- A. City's Estimate:
 - (1) General Subsidence Maintenance and Repairs: \$10,000.

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- (2) Emergency Subsidence Remedial
 Work: Gosts cannot be estimated
 because of the unpredictable nature
 of the work.
- (3) Subsidence Studies: \$335,000.
- B. Staff's Analysis:

Recommend approval of (1) \$10,000 for general Subsidence Maintenance and Repairs, (2) actual subsidence costs incurred, as verified by Commission staff, for Emergency Subsidence Remedial Work, and (3) \$265,000 for Subsidence Studies.

ENVIRONMENTAL CLEARANCE:

The City determined that work under Subsidence Maintenance is within the scope of emergency repairs and as such is categorically exempt under 14 Cal. Adm. Code 15106.

Environmental clearance is not required for Subsidence Studies.

FISCAL IMPACT: Subsidence costs will be borne 100% by the State.

STATUTORY AUTHORITY:

a. City's Reference: Chapter 138/'64

b. Staff's Determination: Chapter 138/'64 1st E.S., Sec.1(e).

DISCUSSION:

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All work o be performed under this approval will conform to the Definitions and Procedures for Subsidence Maintenance and Repairs and Subsidence Studies adopted by the Commission on June 27, 1979 (Minute Item 27).

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The Commission staff has worked jointly with the City to bring about reductions in the cost of vertical measurement surveys. This includes reduction in some survey lines in areas of less elevation change as well as other modifications in the leveling program. These changes should lead to reduced expenditures while still providing the data to monitor ground elevation changes within the City of Long Beach. Therefore, the staff recommends a reduction in the amount to be budgeted for Vertical Measurements and Studies to more nearly approximate the current expenditure trend.

The \$110,000 requested for the Harbor Department expenses relating to subsidence matters is substantially greater than the current expenditure trend. Future expenses should be lower because of fewer subsidence projects. Therefore, the staff would also recommend a reduction in the amount to be budgeted for State Lands Expense under Subsidence Studies.
