INFORMATIVE

In accordance with the Commission's delegation of authority to the Executive Officer for the issuance of dredging permits of 10,000 cubic yards or less, Minute Item No. 32, February 24, 1977, permission was granted on September 20, 1979, to excavate 5800 cubic yards of material from State-owned granted lands to the party named below. Because of regulatory delays, the applicant requested, and the Executive Officer issued, an extension to the permit for:

APPLICANT:

Pacific Gas and Electric Company 77 Beale Street San Francisco, California 94106

The modification extends the term of the permit from August 1, 1980, to July 31, 1981, specifies that all other terms, conditions and requirements of the original permit remain in full force and effect, and requires compliance with the permits, recommendations and limitations of all applicable Federal, State, and local agencies. The original permit allowed removal of 5800 cubic yards of material from the Oakland Inner Harbor between the Cities of Oakland and Alameda, Alameda County, for the placement of electrical cables, with spoils to be deposited at the Corps of Engineers Alcatraz Disposal Site, or if contaminated, at an authorized upland disposal site, with a royalty of \$0.15 per cubic yard for materials deposited on public property and \$0.25 per cubic yard in the event spoils are sold or placed on private property.

- 1. The proposed project is categorically exempt from the requirements of CEQA, pursuant to the provisions of Section 15104 of the CEQA Guidelines as a minor alteration to land with spoils disposal in an approved disposal area.
- 2. Issuance of the permit and the regultant project will have no significant adverse effect on the environment or the environmental characteristics identified pursuant to Section 6370.1 et seq., of the P.R.C.
- 3. The dredging amount will not exceed 10,000 cubic yards.
- 4. A charge per cubic yard will be assessed for spoil material that is deposited on private property or otherwise lost to future State benefit.
- 5. Approval of the project will be contingent upon approval by all pertinent State, Federal and local agencies.

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
