ASSIGNMENT OF GENERAL LEASE - COMMERCIAL USE

ASSIGNOR: Paul A. and Jean Meeks
dba Knights Landing Lone Pine
Boat and Launch Club
P. O. Box 27
Knights Landing, California 95645

ASSIGNEE: Jerry and Margarette Meline
Route 2, Box 245-A
Woodland, California 95695

AREA, TYPE LAND AND LOCATION:
0.161-acre parcel of submerged land in
the Sacramento River near Knights Landing,
Sutter County.

LAND USE: Maintenance of an existing floating wharf
and boat launch.

TERMS OF CURRENT LEASE:
Initial period: 10 years from January 24,
1980.
Surety bond: \$1,000.
Public liability insurance: \$200,000 per
occurrence for bodily
injury and \$50,000 for
property damage, or combined
single limit coverage
of \$200,000.

Consideration: \$225, 5-year rent review.

BASIS FOR CONSIDERATION:
Pursuant to 2 Cal. Adm. Code 2005.

PREREQUISITE TERMS, FEES AND EXPENSES:
Assignee is lessee of upland.

Filing fee and processing costs have been
received.

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STATUTORY AND OTHER REFERENCES:

OTHER PERTINENT INFORMATION:

1. Paul A. and Jean Meeks, dba Knights Landing Lone Pine Boat and Launch Club, have sold their interests in lease PRC 4897.1, issued January 24, 1980, to Jerry and Margarette Meline effective June 23, 1980. The lease being assigned meets current State Lands Commission leasing standards. The new owners also have a lease from Caltrans for the upland.

2. This activity is exempt from CEQA because it does not constitute a project.

Authority: PRC 21065, 14 Cal. Adm. Code 15037 and 15060, and 2 Cal. Adm. Code 2903(d).

3. This project is situated on State land identified as possessing significant environmental values pursuant to P.R.C. 5370.1, and is classified in a use category, Class B, which authorizes Limited Use.

Staff review indicates that there will be no significant effect upon the identified environmental values. This is an existing facility for which no adverse comments have been received.

3. AUTHORIZE APPROVAL OF THE ASSIGNMENT, EFFECTIVE JUNE 23, 1980, OF LEASE PRC 4397 FROM PAUL A. AND JEAN MEEKS TO JERRY AND MARGARETTE MELINE. ALL TERMS AND CONDITIONS OF THE LEASE REMAIN UNCHANGED.

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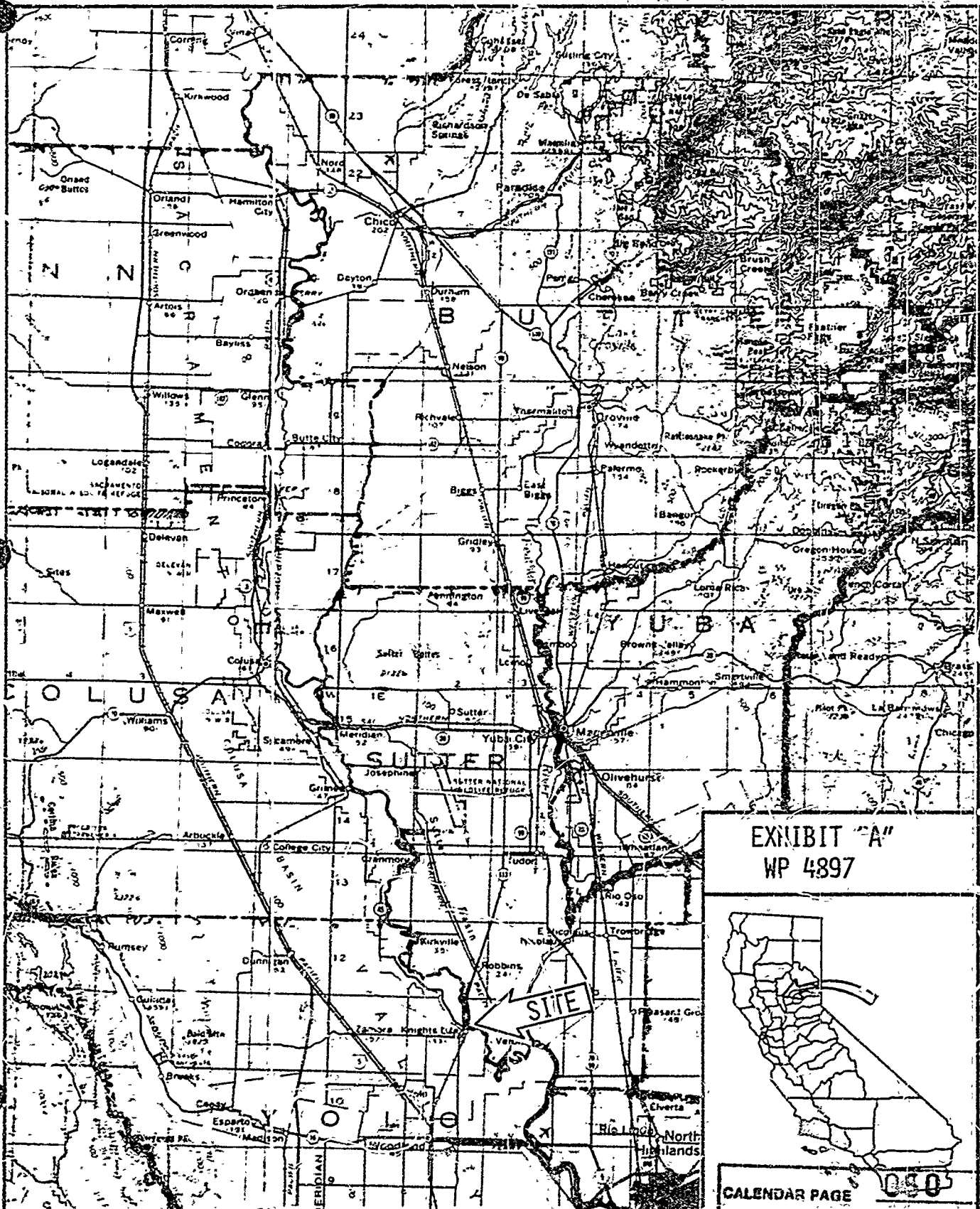
