GENERAL PERMIT - PROTECTIVE STRUCTURE

APPLICANT: Ralph E. Worden and Eileen K. Worden  
341 South Bristol Avenue  
Los Angeles, California 90049

AREA, TYPE LAND AND LOCATION:  
0.07-acre sovereign land at Malibu, Los  
Angeles County.

LAND USE: Protective rock riprap.

TERMS OF PROPOSED PERMIT:  
Initial period: 10 years from February 1,  
1981.

CONSIDERATION: No monetary consideration required in that  
the public benefit will accrue.

The State reserves the right at any time  
to set a monetary rental if the Commission  
finds such action to be in the State's  
best interest.

BASIS FOR CONSIDERATION:  
Pursuant to 2 Cal. Adm. Code 2005.

PREREQUISITE TERMS, FEES AND EXPENSES:  
Applicant is owner of upland.

Filing fee and processing costs have been  
received.

STATUTORY AND OTHER REFERENCES:

2. This project is exempt from CEQA because it will consist of minor alteration to land. During last winter's storms, riprap was placed as an emergency measure at the subject site. Applicant proposes to complete and maintain this protective structure.

Authority: 2 Cal. Adm. Code 2907,  
Class 4(B).

3. This project is situated on State land identified as possessing significant environmental values pursuant to P.R.C. 6370.1, and is classified in a use category, Class C, which authorizes Multiple Use.

Staff has coordinated this project with those agencies and organizations which nominated the site as containing significant environmental values. They have found this project to be compatible with their nomination.

4. Staff feels that shore protection at this location will be of mutual benefit to both the public and the applicant. The shoreline will have additional protection at no cost to the public.
5. This project is located beneath existing deck structures appurtenant to two residences on adjacent land.
6. There is no fixed State boundary at this location.

California Coastal Commission.

2. DETERMINE THAT THE PROJECT IS CONSISTENT WITH THE PROVISIONS OF ARTICLE 6.5, OF TITLE 2, OF THE CAL. ADM. CODE.
3. FIND THAT GRANTING OF THE PERMIT WILL HAVE NO SIGNIFICANT EFFECT UPON ENVIRONMENTAL CHARACTERISTICS IDENTIFIED PURSUANT TO SECTION 6370.1, OF THE P.R.C.
4. AUTHORIZE ISSUANCE TO RALPH E. WORDEN AND EILEEN K. WORDEN OF A 10-YEAR GENERAL PERMIT - PROTECTIVE STRUCTURE USE FROM FEBRUARY 1, 1981, ON FILE IN THE PRINCIPAL OFFICE OF THE STATE LANDS COMMISSION; IN CONSIDERATION OF THE PUBLIC BENEFIT, FOR MAINTENANCE OF PROTECTIVE ROCK RIP RAP ON THE LAND DESCRIBED ON EXHIBIT "A" ATTACHED AND BY REFERENCE MADE A PART HEREOF.

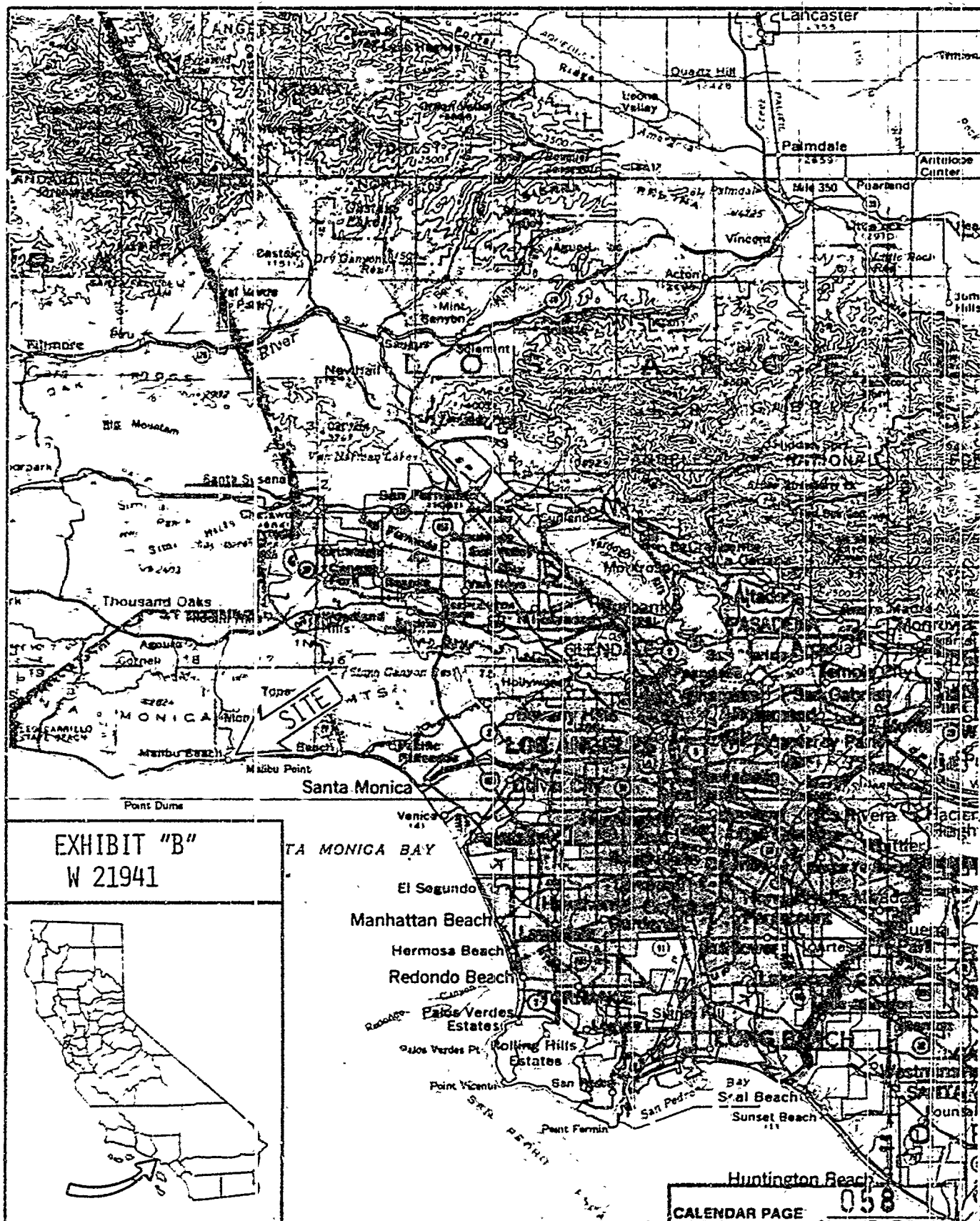
