On May 29, 1980, the State Lands Commission approved Union Oil Company's application to resume crilling operations on State Oil and Gas Lease PRC 2879.1 in Santa Barbara County. The approval was conditioned on the lessee's agreement to an amendment to the lease which provided that Union Oil Company comply with State Lands Commission regulations in force on July 10, 1980.

Due to unforeseen difficulties in filing State Lands Commission regulations applicable to this lease, some regulations did not become effective until July 14, 1980. Therefore, an amendment of the May 29 approval has become necessary.

A document is on file in the Commission's office which has been executed by the lessee and which provides that Commission regulations in effect on July 15, 1930 will be applicable to the lease.
