AREA, TYPE LAND AND LOCATION:

A total of 3.714-acres of tide and submerged land consisting of two parcels on Brannon Island located in Three Mile Slough, Sacramento County; ten parcels on Frinks Tract located in Piper Slough and False River, Contra Costa Caunty.

OTHER PERTINENT INFORMATION:

- is placement of riprap material on portions of the banks of the waterways at Franks Tract State Recreational Area and at Brannan Island State Recreational Area for protection and bank stabilization.

 Both sites are consolidated under one permit to ficilitate processing time:
 - 2. The annual rental value of the twelve parcels at the two sites is estimated to be \$3,240.
 - 3. An EIR is not required. This transaction is within the purview of 14 Cal. Adm. Code, Div. 6, Section 15104, which exempts minor alterations in the condition of land and water.
 - 4. This project is situated on State land identified as possessing significant environmental values pursuant to P.R.C. 6370.1, and is classified in a use category, Class B, which authorizes limited Use.

Staff has coordinated this project with those agencies and organizations which nominated the site as containing significant environmental values. They have found this project to be compatible with their nomination.





