GENERAL PERMIT - RIGHT-OF-WAY USE

APPLICANT: Pacific Telephone and Telegraph Company  
1260 Fulton Avenue  
Sacramento, California 95825

AREA, TYPE LAND AND LOCATION:  
A 0.067-acre area of submerged lands in  
the San Joaquin River at Mossdale Bridge  
near Manteca, San Joaquin County.

LAND USE: Construction, operation and maintenance  
of telephone and telegraph facilities.

TERMS OF PROPOSED PERMIT:  
Special: Continuous use plus one  
year from September 22,  
1981.

CONSIDERATION: Exempt by law, Public Utilities Code 7901.

BASIS FOR CONSIDERATION:  
Pursuant to 2 Cal. Adm. Code 2005.

PREREQUISITE TERMS, FEES, EXPENSES:  
Applicant is permittee of upland.  
Filing fee and processing costs have been  
received.

2. An EIR is not required. This transaction is within the purview of 14 Cal. Adm. Code 15103, Class 3(d), which exempts new construction of small structures.
3. This project is situated on State land identified as possessing significant environmental values pursuant to P.R.C. 6370.1, and is classified in a use category, Class B, which authorizes Limited Use.

Staff has coordinated this project with those agencies and organizations which nominated the site as containing significant environmental values. They have found this project to be compatible with their nomination.

APPROVALS REQUIRED AND OBTAINED:

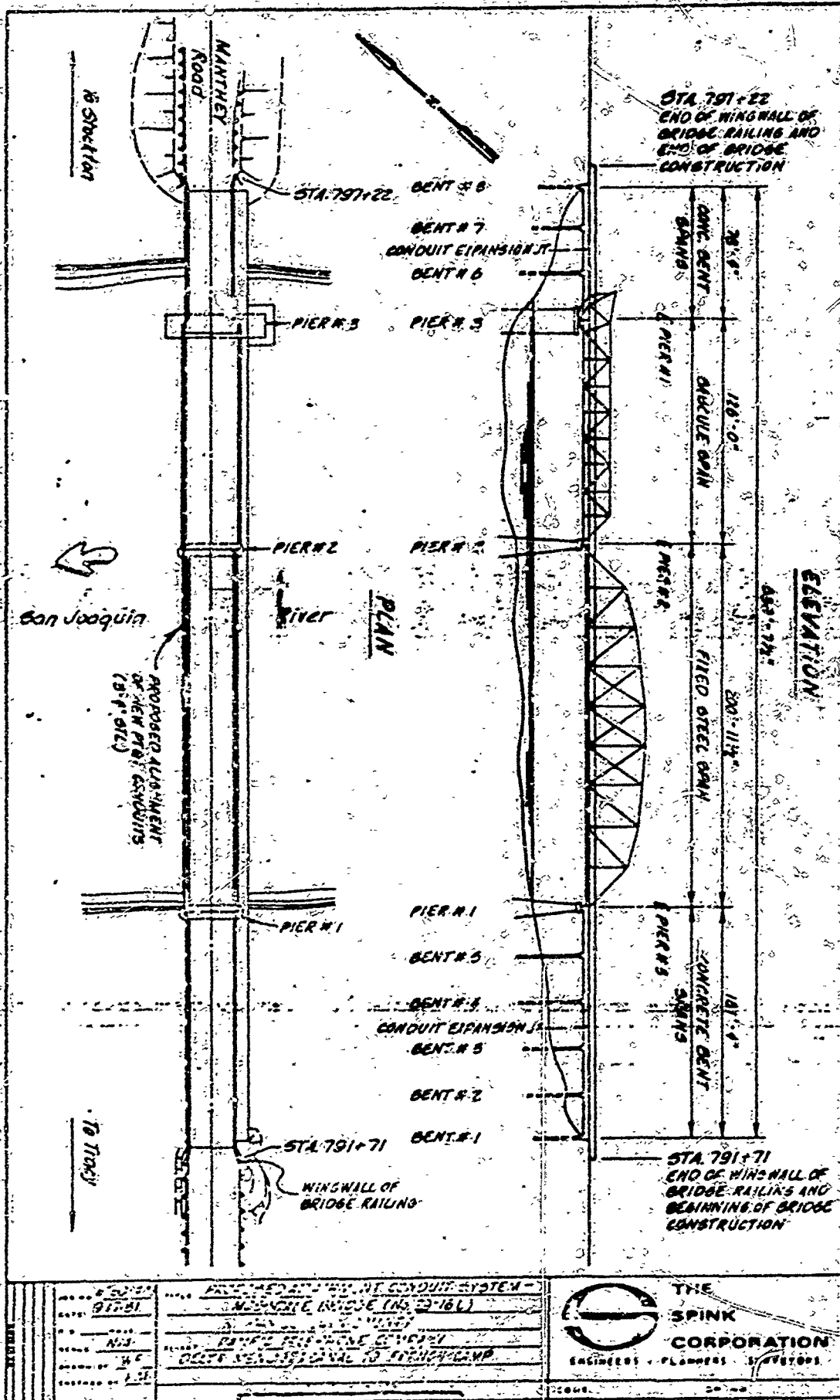
This facility is subject to the jurisdiction of the United States Army Corps of Engineers, California Department of Fish and Game, California Central Valley Regional Water Quality Control Board, California Reclamation Board and the County of San Joaquin. The proposed permit is conditioned on the approval of all agencies having jurisdiction.

1. DETERMINE THAT AN ENVIRONMENTAL DOCUMENT HAS NOT BEEN PREPARED FOR THIS ACTIVITY AS SUCH DOCUMENT IS NOT REQUIRED UNDER THE PROVISIONS OF P.R.C. 21084, 14 CAL. ADM. CODE 15100 ET SEQ., AND 2 CAL. ADM. CODE 2907.
2. FIND THAT GRANTING OF THE PERMIT WILL HAVE NO SIGNIFICANT EFFECT UPON ENVIRONMENTAL CHARACTERISTICS IDENTIFIED PURSUANT TO SECTION 6370.1, OF THE P.R.C.
3. AUTHORIZE ISSUANCE TO PACIFIC TELEPHONE AND TELEGRAPH COMPANY OF A CONTINUOUS USE PLUS ONE YEAR GENERAL PERMIT RIGHT-OF-WAY USE FROM SEPTEMBER 22, 1981, WHICH IS EXEMPT FROM CONSIDERATION PURSUANT TO PUBLIC UTILITIES CODE 7901, FOR CONSTRUCTION, OPERATION AND MAINTENANCE OF TELEPHONE AND TELEGRAPH FACILITIES OVER, ACROSS AND UNDER THE LAND DELINEATED ON EXHIBIT "A" ATTACHED AND BY REFERENCE MADE A PART HEREOF.

 LAND DESCRIPTION

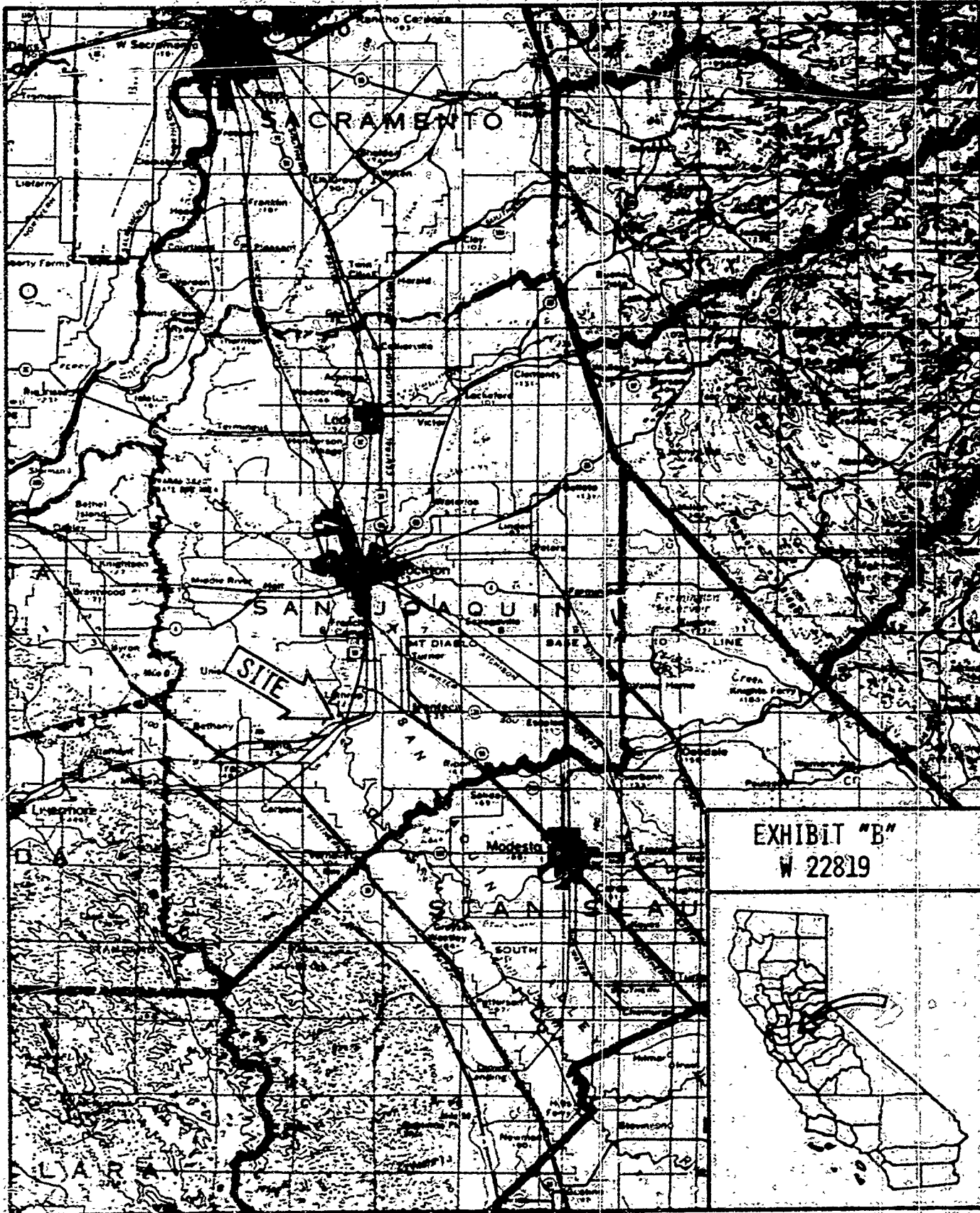
